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Unified Government Public Health Department Will Provide Additional COVID-19 Vaccine Doses for People with Weakened Immune Systems

Third doses available at Kmart site for people moderately to severely immunocompromised

On August 18, the Unified Government Public Health Department (UGPHD) will begin offering additional doses of Pfizer or Moderna COVID-19 vaccines for people who are moderately to severely immunocompromised and who have already been fully vaccinated with the Pfizer or Moderna vaccine.

This follows autho-

rization by the FDA as well as the recommendation of the CDC and the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) to provide third vaccine doses for immunocompromised individuals. The expanded Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) from the FDA does not apply to individuals who received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine.

There is not enough data at this time to determine if an additional dose of Johnson & Johnson vaccine will improve immune response in people who are immunocompromised.

Why these doses are offered

Third doses of mRNA vaccines (Pfizer and Moderna) were authorized by the FDA for people who are

immunocompromised, meaning people who have health conditions that significantly weaken their immune system. For these individuals, their immune system is not able to mount the typical level of immune response with two doses of these vaccines. Adding a third dose helps increase immunity in order to protect a population that is already at higher risk for serious illness or hospitalization if they get COVID.

Offering additional doses for people who are immunocompromised is different from offering vaccine “boosters” for anyone. Booster shots for any immunizations can function to either increase immunity that has waned over time or protect against new virus strains. COVID vaccine boosters for the general population have not been authorized by the FDA at this time. The UGPHD asks that fully vaccinated people who are not immunocompromised do not seek out third doses at this time, and encourages these individuals to await further information and recommendations.

Who is eligible for an additional vaccine dose?

Currently, CDC is

recommending that moderately to severely immunocompromised people receive an additional dose. This includes people who have:

- Been receiving active cancer treatment for tumors or cancers of the blood (hematologic malignancies)

- Received an organ transplant and are taking medicine to suppress the immune system

- Received a stem cell transplant (CAR-T-Cell or hematopoietic stem cell transplant) within the last 2 years or are taking medicine to suppress the immune system

- Moderate or severe primary immunodeficiency (such as DiGeorge syndrome,

Wiskott-Aldrich syndrome)

- Advanced or untreated HIV infection

- Active treatment with high-dose corticosteroids or other drugs that may suppress your immune response (alkylating agents, antimetabolites, transplant-related immunosuppressive drugs, cancer chemotherapeutic agents classified as severely immunosuppressive, TNF blockers and other biologic agents that are immunosuppressive or immunomodulatory)

These individuals must have already re-

ceived two doses of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine, and it must be at least 28 days since their second dose.

People should talk to their healthcare provider about their medical condition, and whether getting an additional dose is appropriate for them.

How it works at the Kmart vaccination site

People who live in Wyandotte county age 12 and older who meet the eligibility criteria above can now come to the UGPHD's vaccination facility to get their third dose of either Pfizer or Moderna COVID-19 vaccination for free.

- The UGPHD encourages patients to bring their COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card to help expedite the process.

- Patients will be asked to sign a form attesting that they need an additional COVID vaccine dose because they are moderately to severely immunocompromised.

- Minors must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. A parent/guardian must sign the attestation form on behalf of their child.

Free COVID-19 vaccinations are available at the former Kmart building at 7836 State Avenue in Kansas City, KS, Wednesday through Friday, 10 am – 6 pm.

Retirement And Taxes: Understanding IRAs

Individual Retirement Arrangements, or IRAs, provide tax incentives for people to make investments that can provide financial security for their retirement. These accounts can be set up with a bank or other financial institution, a life insurance company, mutual fund or stockbroker.

Here's basic overview to help people better understand this type of retirement savings account.

- **Contribution.** The money that someone puts into their IRA. There are annual limits to contributions depending on their age and the type of IRA. Generally, a taxpayer or their spouse must have earned income to contribute to an IRA.

- **Distribution.** The amount that someone withdraws from their IRA.

- **Withdraws.** Taxpayers may face a 10% penalty and a tax bill if they withdraw money

before age 59 ½, unless they qualify for an exception.

- **Required distribution.** There are requirements for withdrawing from an IRA:

- Someone generally must start taking withdrawals from their IRA when they reach age 70.

- Per the 2019 SECURE Act, if a person's 70th birthday is on or after July 1, 2019, they do not have to take withdrawals until age 72.

- **Special distribution rules** apply for IRA beneficiaries.

- **Traditional IRA.** An IRA where contributions may be tax-deductible. Generally, the amounts in a traditional IRA are not taxed until they are withdrawn.

- **Roth IRA.** This type of IRA that is subject to the same rules as a traditional IRA but with certain exceptions:

- A taxpayer cannot deduct contributions to a Roth IRA.

- **Qualified distributions** are tax-free.

- **Roth IRAs** do not require withdrawals until after the death of the owner.

- **Savings Incentive Match Plan for Employees.** This is commonly known as a SIMPLE IRA. Employees and employers may contribute to traditional IRAs set up for employees. It may work well as a start-up retirement savings plan for small employers.

- **Simplified Employee Pension.** This is known as a SEP-IRA. An employer can make contributions toward their own retirement and their employees' retirement. The employee owns and controls a SEP.

- **Rollover IRA.** This is when the IRA owner receives a payment from their retirement plan and deposits it into a different IRA within 60 days.

Section 1. The Governing Body has conducted a hearing to consider the conditions of the property as originally detailed at the July 12, 2021 Edwardsville City Council meeting and has determined that the structure(s) at 1951 South 98th Street is dangerous, unsafe, and unfit for human use or habitation.

Section 2. The Governing Body hereby orders the structure(s) located at 1951 South 98th Street be removed or have a building permit issued to address the noted conditions by September 30, 2021.


