State Treasurer Lynn Rogers Sets Record In Unclaimed Property Returns

State Treasurer Lynn Rogers announced that more than \$6.3 million in unclaimed property was returned to nearly 6,000 Kansans in the month of August, setting a record for a single month.

"We are working hard to reunite Kansans with what is rightfully theirs, and with this record-breaking month, it is clear our efforts are working," said State Treasurer Lynn Rogers. "We have returned money to individuals, school districts, nonprofits, and municipalities all across the state."

Specifically, the Treasurer's Office returned \$6,327,259.89 in the month of August. The state's previous record for a single month, set in 2019, was \$4,226,155.49.

Since taking office in January, State Treasurer Rogers and the Unclaimed Property Division have returned more than \$17 million to nearly 60,000 Kansans with an average property amount of \$290.24. Kansas currently has more than \$400 million in assets to return.

"Now more than ever, every penny counts, and getting this money back to Kansans helps them pay for important expenses or provides a little extra to save for education, housing, or retirement," said Rogers.

Kansans interested in searching for unclaimed property can search online at www.kansascash.ks.gov, or they can find the State Treasurer's Office at the Kansas State Fair starting Friday, September 10 through Sunday, September 19, in the Meadowlark Building.

"The immersive nature of War Remains puts visitors into the boots of brave soldiers."

War Remains visitors have written their thoughts in a notebook in the post-experience area. Among these comments:

- "Amazing! Everyone needs to experience this to 'appreciate' this war."
- "First experience with VR. Unimaginable. Horrific."
- "Truly a marvel of technology being used to bring a new era of museum experience."

The Museum and Memorial is open Tuesday-Sunday from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Online ticket purchases are strongly encouraged. Walk-in visitors to War Remains cannot guarantee that slots are available since tickets are time-specific for this solo experience. Due to the graphic nature of the content, viewers must be at least 14 years of age.

War Remains was produced by MWMi, directed by Brandon Oldenburg, and developed by Flight School Studio, with audio designed by Skywalker Sound. It premiered to international acclaim at the Tribeca Film Festival in 2019 and later opened for a limited run in Austin, Texas. It went on to win the "Out-of-home VR Entertainment of the Year" award at the VR Awards.

WHEREAS, in the attached memorandum (Exhibit A) the County Administrator has recommended to the Board of Commissioners the rates for sewer charges he deems necessary under Section 30-96 of the Unified Government Code, as reflected in the attached Regulation (Exhibit B); and

WHEREAS, the governing body desires to establish the rates for sewer service charges by adopting the attached Regulation; and
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE UNIFIED GOVERNMENT OF WYANDOTTE COUNTY/KANSAS CITY, KANSAS:

ORDINANCE NO. O-120-21

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE MONTHLY FEE ON RESIDENTIAL UNITS IN THE CITY OF KANSAS CITY, KANSAS, TO FUND THE UNIFIED GOVERNMENT'S SOLID WASTE SERVICES, AMENDING SECTION 31-17(b) OF THE UNIFIED GOVERNMENT OF WYANDOTTE COUNTY/KANSAS CITY, KANSAS CODE AND REPEALING ORIGINAL SECTION 31-17(b).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE UNIFIED GOVERNMENT OF WYANDOTTE COUNTY/KANSAS CITY, KANSAS:

Section 1. That Section 31-17(b) of the Unified Government of Wyandotte County/Kansas City, Kansas Code be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

- Sec. 31-17. Service Fee.
- (b) Levy and payment of fee and effective date.
- 1) Effective January 1, 2015, a monthly solid waste fee in the amount of \$15.40 is hereby levied on all single-family residences and all residential units in buildings containing not more than four dwelling units in the City.
- 2) Effective January 1, 2020, a monthly solid waste fee in the amount of \$15.65 is hereby levied on all single-family residences and all residential units in buildings containing not more than four dwelling units in the City
- 3) Effective January 1, 2021, a monthly solid waste fee in the amount of \$16.00 is hereby levied on all single-family residences and all residential units in buildings containing not more than four dwelling units in the City
- 4) Effective January 1, 2022, a monthly solid waste fee in the amount of \$16.25 is hereby levied on all single-family residences and all residential units in buildings containing not more than four dwelling units in the City
- 5) The fee shall be billed and collected through the administrative departments of the Board of Public Utilities of the Unified Government

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and the Board of Public Utilities may discontinue water services to premises for which the fee has not been paid.

6) The solid waste fee shall be a debt due to the Unified Government. If the debt is not paid on the due date, it shall be deemed delinquent and may be recovered by initiating the necessary civil action in the name of the Unified Government against the property owner or the occupant of the premises.

Section 2. That said original Section 31-17(b) of the Unified Government of Wyandotte County/Kansas City, Kansas Code be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective after its passage, approval, and publication in the official Unified Government newspaper.

RESOLUTION NO. R-61-21

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE STATE OF LOCAL HEALTH EMERGENCY FOR THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC FOR THE COUNTY OF WYANDOTTE, KANSAS, THROUGH DECEMBER 16, 2021.

WHEREAS, on the 13th day of March, 2020, the Mayor/CEO of the Unified Government of Wyandotte County/Kansas City, Kansas declared there was a state of local public disaster emergency in Wyandotte County, Kansas, resulting in potential or occurring pandemic known as COVID-19, in Wyandotte County, Kansas;

WHEREAS, on the 19th day of March, the Unified Government Commission adopted Resolution R-18-20 extending the state of local public health emergency through May 18, 2020;

WHEREAS, on the 14th day of May, 2020, the Unified Government Commission adopted Resolution R-30-20, extending the state of local public health emergency through July 17, 2020;

WHEREAS, on the 9th day of July, 2020, the Unified Government Commission adopted Resolution R-37-20, extending the state of local public health emergency through September 15, 2020;

WHEREAS, on the 3rd day of September, 2020, the Unified Government Commission adopted Resolution R-66-20, extending the state of local public health emergency through December 14, 2020;

WHEREAS, on the 3rd day of December, 2020, the Unified Government Commission adopted Resolution R-83-20, later corrected as Resolution R-83a-20 and published on February 4, 2021, extending the state of local public health emergency through March 15, 2021;

WHEREAS, on the 11th day of March, 2021, the Unified Government Commission adopted Resolution R-16-21 and published on March 18, 2021, extending the state of local public health emergency through June 15, 2021;

WHEREAS, on the 10th day of June, 2021, the Unified Government Commission adopted Resolution R-40-21 and published on June 17, 2021, extending the state of local public health emergency through September 15, 2021;

WHEREAS, the threat to the public health from the COVID-19 pandemic continues, as evidenced by the national count of 39,279,057 cases and 638,689 deaths as of September 1, 2021;

WHEREAS, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention reports: that the Delta variant of the COVID-19 virus emerged and became the predominant variant in the country in less than three months; the Delta variant is more than twice as contagious as previous variants; data suggests that the Delta variant might cause more severe illness than previous variants in unvaccinated people; unvaccinated people remain the greatest concern; and fully-vaccinated people with Delta variant breakthrough infections can spread the virus to others;

WHEREAS, as of September 1, 2021: there have been 373,171 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Kansas, with 12,810 hospitalizations, and 5,581 deaths; the daily counts of new cases in Kansas have increased nearly 700% just since July 1, 2021; the monthly testing rate in the state is 3,836 per 100,000 and the monthly positivity rate for the last full month is 10.1%; and the number of COVID-19 patients occupying ICU beds in the state is nearing the highest levels set last winter;

WHEREAS, in Wyandotte County as of September 1, 2021: the rate of testing positivity is 22.7%; total deaths are 333; the two largest cohorts of breakthrough cases have been reported in people in their 40s and 30s; the confirmed case rate per 100,000 is 13,707; Wyandotte County continues to have the highest case rate of Kansas City-metro counties; and the age group with the most cases in the past 14 days are persons aged 10-19;

WHEREAS, the Unified Government Board of Commissioners recognizes that a prolonged public health crisis requires the timely commitment of federal resources that flow to local units of government under an uninterrupted declared emergency;

WHEREAS, coordinated vaccination efforts will be necessary to address the spread of the Delta variant and to implement the roll-out of vaccine boosters, and the Unified Government will incur significant costs associated with those vaccination efforts;

WHEREAS, the Unified Government Board of Commissioners has the authority to further extend the declaration beyond September 15, 2021, as such conditions continue to endanger the public health, safety and welfare of persons within the borders of Wyandotte County, Kansas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE UNIFIED GOVERNMENT OF WYANDOTTE COUNTY/KANSAS CITY, KANSAS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the state of local public health emergency in Wyandotte County, Kansas, initially declared on the 13th day of March 2020, shall continue and remain in effect through December 16, 2021, unless terminated earlier.
2. That the response and recovery aspects of all local disaster plans which are applicable to Wyandotte County, Kansas, shall initiate the rendering of aid and assistance thereunder.
3. That any rights or powers lawfully exercised or any actions taken


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pursuant to local disaster emergency plans shall continue and have full force and effect as authorized by law through December 16, 2021, unless modified or terminated in the manner prescribed by law.

AN ORDINANCE EXPRESSING THE PROPERTY TAXATION POLICY OF THE UNIFIED GOVERNMENT OF WYANDOTTE COUNTY/KANSAS CITY, KANSAS WITH RESPECT TO FINANCING THE 2022 ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE SELF-SUPPORTED MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT AND APPROVING, ADOPTING AND APPROPRIATING THE BUDGET OF THE SELF-SUPPORTED MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT AND LEVYING A TAX FOR THE YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2022.

WHEREAS, on July 28, 2016, pursuant to Ordinance 0-52-16 the Downtown Kansas City, Kansas Self-Supported Municipal Improvement District (the “District”) was established; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 0-52-16 also established a maximum mill levy rate of 13.301 mills for the District; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 0-52-16 also established an Advisory Board for the District; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to K.S.A. 12-17,102(b), the annual levy of taxes within the District shall not be made until the Advisory Board for the District has provided their recommendation to the governing body; and

WHEREAS, on April 29, 2021, the Advisory Board for the District met in open session to discuss their recommendation for the mill levy rate within the District for the year 2022, and the Advisory Board voted to recommend that the mill levy within the District be set at no greater than 12.0 mills for the year 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Advisory Board provided this recommendation to the Unified Government Board of Commissioners by filing their recommendation with the Unified Government Clerk’s Office on May 15, 2022, a copy of which is attached to this Ordinance as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the Unified Government Board of Commissioners sits as the governing body of the District, and, pursuant to K.S.A. 12-17,102(b), the governing body of the District may levy taxes annually within the District to carry out the purposes of the District, if approved by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Unified Government Commission has fully complied with all of the requirements of the Unified Government resolutions and Kansas state statutes with respect to reviewing this budget and holding a public hearing thereon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE UNIFIED GOVERNMENT OF WYANDOTTE COUNTY/KANSAS CITY, KANSAS:

Section 1. The Unified Government Board of Commissioners notified the public on August 26, 2021, in the official county newspaper of the proposed ad valorem tax levies for the 2022 budget for the Downtown Kansas City, Kansas Self-Supported Municipal Improvement District and that all persons were invited and encouraged to attend a public hearing conducted by the Board of Commissioners on September 7, 2021 at 5:00 p.m., in the 5th Floor Conference Room, 701 N. 7th St., Kansas City, Kansas, for the purpose of considering such 2022 budget.


Section 2. After careful public deliberations, the Unified Government Commission has determined that in order to maintain the public services, contracts and improvements which are essential for the Self-Supported Municipal Improvement District in 2022, the Unified Government Commission hereby accepts the determination of the Advisory Board for the District that, in order to carry out the purposes of the District, it will be necessary to levy a rate of not more than 12.0 mills within the District to fund the budget proposed by the Advisory Board.

Section 3. The 2022 Annual Budget for the Downtown Kansas City, Kansas Self-Supported Municipal Improvement District provided to the Unified Government on May 15, 2022 (Exhibit B) is hereby approved and adopted, and a tax for the District is hereby levied in the amount of 10.493 mills within the limits of the District, and the funds from such levy are hereby appropriated on behalf of the District.


Section 4. The governing body certifies that the amounts to be raised by ad valorem property tax levies are within the statutory limitations.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force upon its approval, passage, and publication in the official Unified Government newspaper.



ORDINANCE NO. O-122-21

AN ORDINANCE amending the Storm and Surface Water Utility fee and providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners for the Unified Government of Wyandotte County/Kansas City has under consideration an amendment to the Storm and Surface Water Utility fee ordinance which requires the Board of Commissioners to amend the Storm and Surface Water Utility fee; and







A RESOLUTION amending LHO 8/05/21.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE UNIFIED GOVERNMENT OF WYANDOTTE COUNTY/KANSAS CITY, KANSAS:

Emergency Public Health Order LHO 8/05/21 was issued to mitigate the spread of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) epidemic in Wyandotte County, Kansas, pursuant to the authority provided in K.S.A. 65-119, K.S.A. 65-129b, K.S.A. 65-201, K.S.A. 65-202 and other applicable laws or regulations.

WHEREAS, the Local Health Officer is authorized and required, pursuant to K.S.A. 65-119 and K.S.A. 65-129b to immediately exercise and maintain supervision over known or suspected cases of any infectious or contagious disease during its continuance and to issue orders seeing that all such cases are properly handled and that the provisions of the Kansas public health laws as to isolation, quarantine and disinfection are duly enforced; and

WHEREAS, should the Local Health Officer feel the necessity to issue an order requiring the wearing of face masks the local health officer shall propose the order to the Board of County Commissioners under K.S.A. 65-201(b)(2); and

WHEREAS, the order becomes effective upon approval by the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the worldwide outbreak of COVID-19 and high transmissibility of the Delta variant continue to threaten the life and health of Wyandotte County citizens and visitors as well as the economy and remains a public disaster affecting life, health, property and the public peace; and

WHEREAS, the uncontrolled rise in COVID-19 infections has created a dangerously low number of available physical acute care beds in local hospital facilities; and

WHEREAS, Wyandotte County continues to have exceptionally low vaccination rates with only 40.5 percent of County residents fully vaccinated against COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, it is recognized by experts that when vaccination rates are not sufficiently high, consistent and correct indoor mask usage is the next best form of mitigation against COVID-19 spread in a community; and

WHEREAS, on July 28, 2021 the Centers for Disease Control recommended that fully vaccinated individuals in parts of the country with substantial or high transmission of COVID-19 should wear masks indoors; and

WHEREAS, the Wyandotte County Local Health Officer has determined it to be necessary to issue an order regarding the wearing of face masks; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A 65-201 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated, the Board of Commissioners shall have the power to review, amend, or revoke any order issued by the local health officer; and

WHEREAS, on August 4, 2021, Wyandotte County Local Health Officer, Dr. K. Allen Greiner issued proposed LHO 8/05/21; and

WHEREAS, on August 5, 2021, the Unified Government Board of Commissioners amended proposed LHO 8/05/21; and

WHEREAS, amended LHO 8/05/21 is scheduled to expire on September 16, 2021.



Section 5. The governing body of the Unified Government hereby authorizes and orders the construction of the improvements and acquisition of equipment acquisitions, and financing of the costs related thereto, as set forth in the 2022-2026 Capital Maintenance Improvement Program and the Amended 2021 and 2022 Capital Budget, contained on pages 489-740 of the 2021 Amended Budget and the 2022 Proposed Budget of the Unified Government of Wyandotte County/Kansas City, Kansas, for Wyandotte County and for the City of Kansas City, Kansas, as submitted by the County Administrator and available at https://www.wycokck.org/Departments/Finance/Budget and incorporated by reference herein.

Section 6. The Mayor/CEO, Unified Government Clerk, County Administrator, Unified Government Chief Financial Officer and Unified Government Chief Counsel and other appropriate officers and agents of the Unified Government are hereby authorized and directed to take such action, expend such funds and execute such documents, certificates and instruments as may be necessary or desirable to carry out and comply with the intent of this Resolution and Ordinance.



Vaccine and Testing Clinics Continue Statewide

Vaccine and Testing events will continue to be held in several counties across the state over the coming weeks following FDA approval of Pfizer vaccination

TOPEKA – With the increased presence of the Delta variant in Kansas, local health departments, providers, and community groups are continuing to hold free COVID-19 vaccine and testing clinics. The emergence of the Delta variant poses a dangerous risk to communities across Kansas. On August 23, 2021, the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) approved the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine (also known as Comirnaty) for people 16 years of age and older. The Pfizer vaccine continues to be available through emergency use authorization for people 12-15 years of age and for the administration of a third dose in moderately or severely immunocompromised people.

Additionally, the FDA’s emergency use authorization covers patients 18 and older to receive the Moderna and Johnson & Johnson vaccines. Moderna began the application for full FDA approval in June, nearly a month after Pfizer/BioNTech. Full approval is anticipated in several weeks. Johnson & Johnson has stated they will begin the approval process later this year.

As of September 8, 2021, 50.2% of Kansans have received at least one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine.

The events listed below are part of a sustained effort to mobilize Kansans to get vaccinated and/or tested to stop the spread of COVID-19 to protect themselves and loved ones. Free testing is available to everyone in Kansas, regardless of vaccination status and even if you have been tested before.

The vast majority of new COVID-19 cases in the State of Kansas are the Delta variant. This variant continues to cause the number of cases to rise at the level that was seen in November 2020.

The Delta variant is highly contagious, more than twice as contagious as previous variants. The greatest concern is for those who are unvaccinated. Data shows that this variant causes more severe illness in people who are unvaccinated. The COVID-19 vaccines reduce a person’s risk of contracting the virus, including this variant. Additionally, it has been shown to prevent severe disease and death.
