Kansas City, Kansas Mask Mandate Extended to January 6, 2022

On Thursday evening, November 19, the Unified Government Commission voted to extend its previous mask order for Kansas City, Kansas and the unincorporated area of Loring in Wyandotte County through 11:59 pm on January 6, 2022.

The resolution extending the mask order will be signed into effect by the Wyandotte County Clerk later today. The proposed resolution to extend the mask order, as reviewed and adopted by the UG Commission last night, can be viewed here.

The same mask require-

ments and exemptions from the original order remain in place. Masks will continue to be required in indoor public spaces for people who are vaccinated and people who are unvaccinated. The order excludes public and private schools and also excludes the cities of Bonner Springs and Edwardsville, Kansas. When adopting the original order on August 5, 2021, the UG Commissioners opted to leave the decision of mask requirements to school boards and to Bonner Springs and Edwardsville elected officials, respectively.

Unified Government Commission Meeting Update

At the Unified Government

Full Commission meeting last night, representatives from the Unified Government Public Health Department (UGPHD) presented a COVID update and recommended a mask order extension until early January. UGPHD representatives noted several considerations for extending the mask mandate:

- Winter weather and the holidays mean more time indoors, where COVID spreads more easily.
- COVID surges are being seen now across the country and in Europe.
- Children under 5 are still ineligible for COVID vaccination
 - Nearly half of people

living in Wyandotte County remain unvaccinated.

- Immunity is waning for people vaccinated more than six months ago.
- · Hospital resources remain under pressure.

What is Covered by the Mask Order

Individuals age five and older must wear masks over the nose and mouth when:

- Inside any public space including businesses and places of worship;
- · Obtaining services from the healthcare sector in settings including, but not limited
- to, a hospital, pharmacy, medical clinic, laboratory, physician or dental office, vaccination site, COVID-19 testing site, veterinary clinic, or blood bank (unless otherwise directed by an employee or healthcare provider);
- · Waiting for or riding on public transportation or while in a taxi, private car service, or ride-sharing vehicle; and

All businesses or organizations in Wyandotte County must require all employees, customers, visitors, members, or members of the public to wear a mask or other face covering when:

- Employees are working in any space visited by customers or members of the public, regardless of whether anyone from the public is present at the time; or
- Employees are working in an indoor space; or
- Employees are working in any space where food is prepared or packaged for sale or distribution to others; or
 - In any indoor space where

members of the general public are present or may be periodically present

State of Kansas Pays Off Long-Standing Debt Two Years Ahead of Schedule

TOPEKA - Governor Laura Kelly today announced the State of Kansas has paid off the long-standing Pooled Money Investment Board (PMIB) "Bridge Loan." In 2017 the Legislature took out this loan to fill budget holes due to poor fiscal management of the previous

"Government, just like every Kansan, has to balance its checkbook," Governor Laura Kelly said. "Thanks to three years of fiscal responsibility, we've paid off this debt, continue to fund our schools and roads, and we can afford good policy – like axing the state's food tax – to provide tax relief to Kansas families."

The Pooled Money Investment Board (PMIB) is a state board that manages and invests the money available from the State General Fund (SGF) and the hundreds of other state and local funds deposited with the State Treasurer.

In 2017, as a result of poor fiscal policy from the previous administration, the state was forced to borrow a "bridge loan" – a loan of over \$300 million from the Pooled Money Investment Board to fill budget holes. The budget had to meet cash flow requirements per state law.

"Because of Governor Kelly's leadership and due to her prudent fiscal decisions, the budget has not only stabilized - but reenergized the economy," Budget Director Adam Proffitt said. "Kansas is now in a position to pay off the loan two years ahead of its original schedule – and that's no small task, especially during uncertain economic times."

Even with paying off the loan two years ahead of schedule, Governor Kelly has been able to:

- Fully fund Kansas' schools 3 years in a row;
- Create over 30,000 jobs;
- Bring in over \$7 billion business dollars invested
- Implement a statewide bipartisan infrastructure program that created more than 130 infrastructure projects to improve our roads, bridges, and broadband accessibility.
