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New Funding to Improve Community Health and Alleviate Poverty Unified Government receives \$689K grant for AmeriCorps VISTA Program

Kansas City, KS – On February 10, 2022, Representative Sharice Davids announced that AmeriCorps awarded \$689,595 to the United Government of Wyandotte County and Kansas City, KS (UG) to improve community health and strive to eliminate poverty by placing AmeriCorps VISTA members in the Kansas Third.

The 2021-2022 grant funding is the Unified Government's eighth year as an AmeriCorps grantee. During the initial grant funding in 2014, four AmeriCorps VIS-TA members served in the Mayor's office and since then the program has expanded to over 11 UG departments and nine community partner agency placements. With having over 90 individuals sworn into service since 2014, the UG is the largest AmeriCorps VISTA intermediary program in the state of Kansas.

"We thank Representative Davids and her office for the continued support and funding of the AmeriCorps VISTA program within the Unified Government," said Mayor Tyrone Garner. "The service of VISTA members brings great value to our UG departments and community organizations. Their skills not only directly benefit our organization but support community empowerment across Wyandotte County. I want to reiterate that the support of Congresswoman Sharice Davids is both valued and appreciated. Again, on behalf of Wyandotte County KCK, thank you Representative Davids."

With the additional funding support, the UG AmeriCorps VISTA program has been able to increase the number of available positions to allow for 35 year-round positions and 20 summer members to work full-time within various departments. The secured funding has also allowed for one additional full-time staff person to be hired to assist with the VISTA program.

UG AmeriCorps VISTA members have served in various UG departments such as public health, the budget office, public works, and planning + urban design to name a few. VISTA members also serve in different roles in area organizations and provide direct support with the focus on community engagement, local health initiatives, neighborhood revitalization efforts and capacity building for organizations that support sustainable solutions to poverty in Wyandotte County. The majority of partner agency placement sites are located in Wyandotte County, but there are some sites that exist across county lines. Regardless of the site location all VISTA positions directly benefit Wyandotte County

residents

"The Unified Government is a proud AmeriCorps grantee. With the continued support from AmeriCorps and specifically the AmeriCorps North Central Regional Office, we have seen impacts in areas from community engagement and outreach to violence prevention and everything in between," said Alli Zuel, AmeriCorps Initiatives Supervisor, Unified Government Public Health Department. "We have had AmeriCorps members in our program coordinate 700+ volunteers in our COVID-19 vaccination clinics, support local organizations with programming and communications, and assist with the implementation of new programs all right here in WyCo. AmeriCorps members are helping us work towards a healthier and safer Wyandotte County." Get Involved

The good news for those who watch crime statistics in Kansas City, Kansas, is that the homicide rate has decreased from 58 during 2020 to 51 during 2021.

One of the more significant concerns of the Kansas City, Kansas, Police Department is staffing. Maj. Dustin Dungan, who recently reported to the Midtown and West Patrol Police Advisory Committee, said the police force has 369 officers authorized but only has 316 serving now; there are 25 prospective officers in training.

Maj. Dungan said the Police Department hopes that a grant will be awarded to the Department that will add license plate readers at various additional locations; presently there are about ten such readers in Kansas City, Kansas.

Maj. Dungan had praise for Village West merchants who were very cooperative with police in apprehending shoplifters.

The West Patrol building at 1011 N. 80th Ter. has been remodeled and will host the Advisory Committee meetings starting at 11a.m. Thursday, Feb. 24.

In a related announcement, Police Chief Karl Oakman said the Department will have a new cold case unit; Capt. Angela Garrison will lead the unit. Chief Oakman said there are about 285 such cases that deserve a fresh review. He said DNA and other such forensic testing may have not be available when the crime was committed.

penses or mayor; amending origi-nal Section 2-58 of the Code of the Unified Government of Wyandotte County/ Kansas City, Kansas.

Whereas, Chapter 3 of the Wyan-dotte County/Kansas City, Kansas Consolidation Study Commission Report, dated January 13, 1997, (denoted Section II. A. 3 in the Recommendation Summary) concerning the compensation, benefits and expenses of mayor provides Compensation: The new Chief

Executive/Mayor will be compensated at the same rate as the current Mayor of Kansas City, Kansas. The same benefits that are authorized to the Mayor now will be authorized to the new Chief Executive/Mayor. However, a government car will be provided for the official use of the Chief Executive/Mayor in lieu of mileage reimbursement.

Whereas, said provisions were codified in Ordinance 2-58 by original Section 3.08 of Resolution No. R-1-97; and

Whereas, section 2-58 of Chapter 2 of the Code of the Unified Government sets out the compensation, benefits and expenses of the Mayor, and

Whereas, said provisions were later amended in Resolution No. R-56-17.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT OR-DAINED BY THE BOARD OF COM-MISSIONERS OF THE UNIFIED GOVERNMENT OF WYANDOTTE COUNTY/KANSAS CITY, KANSAS:

Section 1. That Section 2-58 of Chapter 2 of the Code of the Unified Government of Wyandotte County/Kansas City, Kansas, be and is hereby amended and shall read as follows: Sec. 2-58. – Compensation,

benefits and expenses of mayor. (a) The annual compensation of the mayor shall be not less than \$120,000.00. Said salary shall be subject to an annual cost of living increase as set forth on paragraph (b) and such salary shall go into effect the beginning of the term commencing in 2022. The mayor shall receive the same benefits including, but not limited to, medical and dental nsurance and participation in the Kansas Public Employee Retirement System and such other benefits as may be as was provided to the mayor of Kansas City, Kansas, as of September 30, 1997. The mayor, as an elected official, shall not accrue or accumulate compensatory time, sick leave, personal leave or vacation and shall not be paid out for any unused time upon leaving office. The mayor shall be provided a unified government car, fuel and maintenance for use during the term of office. (b) The mayor shall receive an

annual cost of living increase based on the average of the Consumer Price Index and the average annual increase provided under collective bargaining agreements to bargaining units taken as a whole and their average and to which the unified government is a signatory party for the year prior to January 1 of each

(c) The salary of the mayor may be increased or reduced by legis-lative action of the commission; provided that the general election of the mayor follows the adoption of the ordinance by at least 120 days. No ordinance reducing the salary of the mayor shall become effective until the date of the commencement of the term of the mayor elected at the next general election. The mayor shall receive payment of actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of the duties of the office in such form and manner as the commission may authorize.
