AG Derek Schmidt: Victim assistance grant opportunities open for application

THURSDAY, APRIL 14, 2022

 Six grant programs serving victims of crime across Kansas are open for application, Kansas Attorney General Derek Schmidt announced today.

More than \$2.5 million in grant funds were awarded last year from six different state programs through the office of the attorney general. Funds are used to assist local and state crime victim assistance organizations across Kansas in providing direct services to crime victims, as well as in developing prevention programs to address violence.

Grant opportunities are open in the following programs:

Child Exchange and Visita-

tion Center Program (CEVC) This fund seeks to provide supervised child exchange and visitation to children and families at risk due to circumstances relating to domestic or family violence.

Human Trafficking Victim Assistance Fund (HTVAF) This fund was established by the Legislature in 2013 (K.S.A. 75-758) to provide training regarding human trafficking for law enforcement agencies throughout Kansas, and to support the care, treatment and other services for victims of human trafficking and commercial sexual exploitation of a child.

Child Abuse and Neglect (CVAF-CA)-This fund seeks

ating expenses of programs assisting child victims.

Crime Victims Assistance Fund (CVAF) - This fund seeks to provide for ongoing operating expenses of programs assisting crime victims, and establishing and maintaining new programs providing services to the victims of crimes.

State Protection from Abuse Fund (PFA)—This fund seeks to provide temporary emergency shelter for adult victims of domestic violence or sexual assault and their dependent children, counseling and assistance to those victims and their children, or educational services directed

to provide for ongoing oper- at reducing the incidence of domestic violence or sexual assault and diminishing its impact on victims.

Child Advocacy Center Fund (CAC): This fund seeks to provide for ongoing operating expenses of Child Advocacy Centers.

on the website. All applications are due on May 3, 2022.

Awards will be made this summer. These grant programs are administered by the attorney general's Victim Services Division.

Governor Kelly Announces \$51 Million in Bonus Payments to Direct Support Workers

TOPEKA - Governor Laura Kelly today announced \$51 million would be distributed to Medicaid home and community-based services (HCBS) providers beginning in June of this year. The bonuses will benefit approximately 24,000 direct support workers in the state. Each care worker could receive up to a \$2,000 bonus.

ORDINANCE NO. 0-52-22

An ordinance relating to Chapter 35 - Traffic, Article V - Speed Regulations, amending Section 35-285 – Racing on Highways, of the Code of Ordinances for the Unified Government of Wyandotte County/Kansas City, Kansas

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE UNIFIED GOVERNMENT OF WYANDOTTE COUNTY/KANSAS

CITY, KANSAS
Section 1. That Chapter 35 Traffic, Article V - Speed Regulations, amending Section 35-285 - Racing on Highways, of the Code of Ordinances for the Unified Government of Wyandotte County/Kansas City, Kansas, to read as follows:

Sec. 35-285. – Racing on Highways; Sideshows; Spectators.

(a) No person shall drive any vehicle in any race, speed competition or contest, drag race or acceleration contest, test of physical endurance, exhibition of speed or acceleration, or for the purpose of making a record, and no person shall in any manner participate in any such race, competition, contest, test, exhibition, or sideshow.

(b) No person shall knowingly be present as a spectator at any race, speed competition or contest, drag race or acceleration contest, test of physical endurance, exhibition,

(c) No person shall knowingly be present as a spectator where preparations are being made for any race, speed competition or contest, drag race or acceleration contest, test of physical endur-

ance, exhibition, or sideshow.
(d) The following words, terms, and phrases, when used in this section, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this subsection, except where the context clearly indicates a different meaning:

Drag race means the operation of two or more vehicles from a point side by side at accelerating speeds in a competitive attempt to out-distance each other or the

operation of one or more vehicles over a common selected course from the same point to the same point for the purpose of compar-ing the relative speeds or power of acceleration of such vehicle or vehicles within a certain distance or time limit.

Racing means the use of one or more vehicles in an attempt to out gain, outdistance or prevent another vehicle from passing, to arrive at a given destination ahead of another vehicle or vehicles, or to test the physical stamina or endur ance of drivers over long-distance driving routes.

Sideshow means an informal demonstration of automotive stunts. Common activities at sideshows include doughnuts and ghost riding.

Spectator includes any individual knowingly present at to observe and purposely demonstrates through active encouragement, assistance, facilitation, urging, promotion or request that any race, speed competition or contest, drag race or acceleration contest test of physical endurance, exhibition, or sideshow commence or continue. Unintentional witness es or passersby to such eyents are not considered spectators, as a spectator is one who attends an event for the purpose of viewing it. (e) Exceptions

(1) Nothing in this section prohibits law enforcement officers or their agents from being spectators at events described herein, when in the course of their official duties

(2) This section shall not apply to races or sideshows that occur on public or private racetracks intentionally built and utilized for such activities.

(1) A violation of subsection (a) is a class C, misdemeanor.

(2) A violation of subsections (b) or (c) are infractions punishable by a fine up to

\$500.00. (Code 1964. § 36-71: Code 1988, § 35-266; Ord. No. 53410, § 1, 1-7-1975)

On April 7, 2022, the governing body of the Unified Government of Wyandotte County/Kansas City, Kansas (the "Issuer") passed an ordinance entitled:

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZ-ING THE ISSUANCE OF SALES TAX SPECIAL OBLIGATION REV ENUE BONDS (VILLAGE EAST PROJECT AREAS 2B, 3 AND 5) SERIES 2022 IN AN AGGREGATE



ORIGINAL PRINCIPAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$160,000,000 FOR THE PURPOSE OF PRO-VIDING FUNDS TO FINANCE CERTAIN COSTS RELATING TO THE VILLAGE EAST PROJECT AREAS 2B, 3 AND 5 PROJECT PLANS AND REFUND CERTAIN PRIOR BONDS; AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE EXECU-TION OF CERTAIN DOCUMENTS IN CONNECTION WITH THE IS-SUANCE OF SAID BONDS; AND AUTHORIZING CERTAIN OTHER ACTIONS IN CONNECTION WITH THE ISSUANCE OF SAID BONDS

The Ordinance authorizes the Issuer to issue its Sales Tax Special Obligation Revenue Bonds (Village East Project Areas 2B, 3 and 5) in the aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$160,000,000 (the "Bonds"), for the purpose of (a) financing certain costs relating to a STAR Bond project within a STAR Bond Project District created by the Issuer and (b) refunding certain outstanding bonds of the Issuer, as more fully described in the Bond Trust Indenture authorized by the Ordinance. and retain qualified staff."

Provider agencies will receive a payment amount based on their number of current direct care workers and immediate supervisors. All funds go directly to direct service workers and their immediate supervisors. Additionally, as an incentive to bring more direct support workers to the field, agencies will receive \$1,500 dollars per new staff for a recruitment bonus.

The bonus payments are available through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) signed into law in March 2021 to provide enhanced federal funding for Medicaid HCBS through a one-year 10 percent increase to the state's Federal Medical Assistance Percentages (FMAPs). FMAPs are the percentage rates used to determine the amount of matching federal funds allocated annually for

sate expenditures to social services and state and medical insurance programs.

The distribution of that funding will be administered by KDADS and the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE). The distribution plan has received federal approval and its goal is to improve access to quality services and increase capacity for Kansans, including those with disabilities and behavioral health challenges, to receive care in their homes and communities and to serve as a catalyst to enhance provider staffing to optimal levels and retain direct supports workers.

KDHE is the single state Medicaid (KanCare) agency. KDADS administers the state's 1915(c) HCBS waivers and oversees the state's PACE programs; the majority of ARPA spending will occur within KDADS-sponsored projects.

Governor Kelly Announces \$13.2 Million Awarded for **Public Transit Projects**

SALINA-Governor Laura Kelly, joined by Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Administrator Nuria Fernandez and Kansas Transportation Secretary Julie Lorenz, announced \$13.2 million will go toward 48 public transit projects across the state.?

"A strong, safe public transportation system is critical to our state's economy and quality of life," Governor Laura

That money will go to 26 transit agencies as part of the Access, Innovation, and Collaboration (AIC) Public Transit

The announcement took place at the OCCK, Inc., Transportation complex in Salina in an expanded bus facility funded by the Kansas Department of Transportation and an FTA grant, with support from the City of Salina and OCCK. The 16,000 square-foot expansion was completed in November 2021.

"This work reflects the tremendous partnership between all levels of government," FTA Administrator Fernandez said.

"In addition to funding new bus facilities and improving transit service, the grants support the purchase of low- or no-emission buses. That work throughout Kansas will accelerate the transition to cleaner, more efficient transportation system, and help keep our skies blue, our water clean and our climate more predictable by reducing greenhouse gas

Both urban and rural transit providers receive support from the AIC program, which will improve transit access and services for Kansans. The projects have a total cost of about \$17M, with the AIC program providing about \$13M (\$2M state, \$11M federal) of the funds.

In the first two years of the AIC program, KDOT will have awarded \$21 million in funding for a total project cost of \$26 million.?

"The AIC Public Transit Program combines state and federal resources that will enhance access to transit, invest in emerging technologies and form collaborations with public and private transportation providers," Secretary Lorenz said.
