## AG Schmidt urges caution for consumers in wake of severe storms

TOPEKA – Kansas Attorney General Derek Schmidt today urged Kansans to be cautious as they react to last Friday's severe storms that struck the state and caused widespread damage to homes and communities.

Schmidt said it was important for Kansans to know their rights under the Kansas Consumer Protection Act as it relates to home or business repairs, as well as using diligence when giving to charitable organizations assisting with relief efforts.

"As the road to recovery begins, it is important for consumers to be on guard against scammers and unscrupulous businesses looking to profit from the tragedy of others," Schmidt said.

Staff from the attorney general's Consumer Protection Division have been in contact with local officials in storm-damaged areas to assist in responding to contractors and consumers.

Schmidt advised particular caution in three regards:

**ROOFERS:** With few exceptions, the Kansas Roofing Registration Act requires roofing contractors who operate in Kansas to obtain a registration certificate from the Kansas Attorney General in order to legally solicit or provide commercial or residential roofing services for a fee. The act is designed to ensure that legitimate roofing contractors are complying with state requirements, such as carrying appropriate insurance, and to help prevent "fly-by-night" operators from taking

advantage of Kansas consumers. The requirement to register with the attorney general's office is in addition to any other local requirements that cities, counties, or other governments may impose. The online directory of registered roofers is available at [www.InYourCornerKansas.org](http://www.InYourCornerKansas.org).

Working with a roofer that is registered is a bare minimum to help prevent problems.

**DOOR-TO-DOOR PEDDLERS:** Under Kansas law, any door-to-door sale must include a three-day right to cancel for any purchase of \$25 or more made at your home, or any location that is not the seller's permanent place of business or local address. The seller must give you written and verbal notice of this right to cancel and contact information if you choose to exercise your right to cancel. It is also suggested you send this cancellation by certified mail so you can track it. Companies are then required to refund the customer's money within 10 days of receiving the cancellation. If you pay for a door-to-door sale with a check, the seller is not allowed to cash or deposit that check until five business days have passed since the transaction. This is to give you a chance to exercise your three-day right to cancel. Because of this rule, it's especially important to never pay for a door-to-door sale in cash, since it becomes

impossible to exercise this option to cancel the transaction and stop payment on the check.

The attorney general's office also recommends the following tips in dealing with any transient contractors, including those selling repairs door-to-door:

- Get recommendations from people you know and references from the contractor.
- Get at least three written estimates from different contractors.
- Check contractor complaint records with the Better Business Bureau.
- Understand your payment options and right to cancel.
- Do not pay for the full amount of the work up front.

**CHARITIES:** Schmidt also reminded Kansans to do their homework and be on guard against scams or unscrupulous charities seeking to profit from the disaster. Numerous organizations have established avenues for making charitable contributions to provide food, shelter and other resources to the victims from Friday's storms. Schmidt said Kansans should be wary of solicitors who appear to be legitimate but use a name that is slightly modified from a well-known charity, or use a misleading online address to redirect well-intended contributions.

Schmidt said the safest way to avoid charities fraud perpetrated through email, text or telephone scams is for

Kansans to take control of their own charitable giving. Kansans should develop their own proactive giving plan and give directly to the charities of their choice, ensuring that the maximum portion of a contribution goes to disaster relief itself rather than fundraising expenses. In addition, giving to well-established local charities that support disaster and recovery activities can maximize the benefit of each contribution and help avoid giving to scams.

The Office of the Attorney General is responsible for enforcement of the Kansas Charitable Organizations and Solicitations Act and protecting consumers from fraudulent charitable and solicitation activities. The City of Bonner Springs, Kansas (the “City”), will conduct a public hearing at 7:30 p.m. (or as soon thereafter as is practical) on May 23, 2022, in the Council Chambers at City Hall, 200 E. 3rd Street, Bonner Springs, Kansas, to consider applying to the Board of Tax Appeals of the State of Kansas to grant an exemption from ad valorem taxes pursuant to K.S.A. 79-201a Second or Twenty-Fourth, as amended, for property financed with the proceeds of approximately \$89,500,000 maximum principal amount of industrial revenue bonds (the “Bonds”) in accordance with K.S.A. 12-1740 to 121749d, inclusive, as amended. The Project will be owned by or leased to Medline Industries, LP, an Illinois limited partnership, or its assigns (the “Company”). Application for the exemption will be conditioned on agreement by the Company to make certain payments in lieu of taxes which payments will be apportioned and paid by the Treasurer of the Unified Government of Wyandotte County and Kansas City, Kansas to all taxing subdivisions in the territory in which the Project is located in the manner provided by K.S.A. 121742. The Bonds and the interest thereon will not be a debt or general obligation of the City, the State of Kansas or any municipal corporation thereof, and neither the Bonds nor the interest thereon are payable in any manner from tax revenues of any kind or character.

The meeting and hearing will be open to the public. Interested members of the public are invited to attend the hearing and will have an opportunity to express their views with respect to the exemption. Written comments with respect to the exemption may also be submitted to the City Clerk before the hearing. Additional information regarding the exemption may be obtained in advance of the hearing from the City Clerk.

CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 38

A Home Rule Ordinance of the City of Bonner Springs, Kansas, Relating to the Creation of a Code Enforcement Administrative Penalty Process.

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Bonner Springs, Kansas, (the "City") has considered the needs of the City and its ability to effectively enforce housing and property maintenance codes thus providing for the general welfare of the City and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the City is authorized by Article 12, Section 5 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas (the "Home Rule Amendment") to determine its local affairs and government, and provided such power and authority granted thereby to cities shall be liberally construed for the purpose of giving cities the largest measure of self-government; and

WHEREAS, there is no enhancement of the Kansas Legislature which prohibits the City from enforcing the Code of the City of Bonner Springs, Kansas, by way of administrative citations, for police power purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City hereby finds that pursuant to and in furtherance of the purposes of the Home Rule Amendment, it is in the interest of the public health, safety and welfare of the City to create a code enforcement administrative citation penalty process, for police power purposes;

Now, Therefore Be It Ordained By The Governing Body Of The City Of Bonner Springs:

Section 1. Section 11-201. Notice of Violation. is to read as follows:

(a) Address or legal description of the premises; (b) Statement of the date of the violation(s) and a description of the conditions which caused the code violation to include the section of code determined to have been violated;

(c) Corrective order that allows ten (10) days from the date of the mailing of a violation notice to bring the premises into compliance; (d) Entitlement to request an appeal process wherein a person in receipt of a notice of violation has ten (10) days from the date of the mailing of the violation notice to request a hearing on the matter before the Governing Body, as provided in Section 11-206; and

(e) Information concerning the penalty for failure to abate the violation or to request a hearing within the time allowed: (1) The amount of the penalty the citee is to pay; (2) The date, 30 days from issuance of the citation, by which the citee must pay the penalty; (3) The method of paying the penalty; and

(4) That failure to pay the penalty, abate the violation, and/or request a hearing within the time allowed may result in prosecution under Section 11-204 and/or abatement of the condition(s) by the City or its authorized agent under Section 11-205 with the costs assessed against the property, either by lien or special assessment, under Section 11-207.

(f) Notice that the citee's payment of the penalty does not excuse continued or subsequent violation(s) of the code. Notice and opportunity to remedy a violation shall be considered given if a previous notice

has been sent within the previous 24 months.

Section 2. Section 11-204. Penalty. is to read as follows:

(a) Any person, who shall violate a provision of this Chapter, or fail to comply therewith, or with any of the requirements thereof, shall be guilty of a Class C violation as prescribed by the Public Offense Code of the City and shall be prosecuted within the limits provided by State or local laws. Each day that a violation continues after due notice has been served shall be deemed a separate offense. The application of the above penalty shall not be held to prevent the abatement of prohibited conditions.

(b) Re-inspection Fees. If the owner fails to abate a violation by the stated re-inspection date, the owner will be charged a failed re-inspection fee for each unabated violation. Additionally, if a Notice to Appear is issued to the owner, a failed pre-court inspection fee will be charged for each and every court appearance. Payment is due within 30 days following receipt of the notice to pay and if not received, the costs will be assessed according to 11-207(b).

(c) Administrative Citation. Any person who shall violate a provision of this Chapter, or fail to comply therewith, or with any of the requirements thereof, may be issued an administrative citation and be required to pay a civil penalty as listed in the City Fee Schedule for each separate violation of a code provision within any 24-month period. A citation may be issued under this section every thirty (30) days by any enforcement officer until such violation is corrected.

Section 3. 11-206. Means of Appeal. is to read as follows:

Any person directly affected by a decision of the Code Official or a notice or order issued under this Code shall have the right to appeal to the Governing Body. Such request for an appeal shall be made in writing to the City Clerk within ten (10) days from the mailing, delivery, or posting of the notice. Failure to make a timely request for an appeal shall constitute a waiver of the person's right to contest the findings of the Code Official before the Governing Body. If an administrative citation was issued and the citee files a timely request for an appeal, the requirement to pay the penalty shall be suspended and the payment of the penalty, if any, shall be in accordance with the decision of the Governing Body. A hearing on the appeal shall be held by the Governing Body as soon as possible after the filing of the request and the person shall be advised by the City of the time and place of the hearing at least five (5) days in advance thereof. At any such hearing, the person may be represented by counsel, and the person and the City may introduce such witnesses and evidence as is deemed necessary and proper by the Governing Body. The hearing need not be conducted according to the formal rules of evidence. If the citee requesting the review fails to appear, the Governing Body shall uphold the decision of the Code Official, the notice or order issued, and any fees and/or citations. Upon conclusion of the appeal hearing, the Governing Body shall record its determination of the matter by adoption of a resolution and serving the resolution upon the person in the matter provided in Section 11-205. Any person affected by any determination of the Governing Body under Sections 11-205 or 11-206 may appeal such determination in the manner provided by K.S.A. 60-2101.

Section 4. Section 11-207. Costs Assessed. is to read as follows:

If the City abates the violation pursuant to 11-205, and/or charges a failed re-inspection fee

pursuant to Section 11-204(b), and/or charges an administrative citation pursuant to Section 11-204(c), the City shall give notice to the owner or his or her agent by First Class Mail of the total cost of the abatement incurred by the City, and/or the failed re-inspection fee, and/or the total administrative citation. The notice shall also state that the payment is due and payable within (30) days following receipt of the notice. If the notice is not paid within the (30) day period, the payment shall be collected in the following manner:

(a) Under provisions outlined in K.S.A. 12-1,115, and amendments thereto; or

(b) By lien or levy of a special assessment against the property on which the violation is located until the full cost and applicable interest has been paid in full. The City Clerk, at the time of certification of other City taxes, shall certify the unpaid portion of the costs and the County Clerk shall extend the same on the tax rolls of the County against such property and it shall be collected by the County Treasurer and paid to the City as other City taxes are collected and paid; or

(c) May be collected through the Kansas State Set-off Program or another collection agency; or

(d) By use of all available legal means.

Section 5. This charter ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper.

Section 6. This charter ordinance shall take effect 61 days after final publication unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed and a referendum held on the ordinance as provided in Article 12, Section 5, of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, in which case the ordinance shall become effective if approved by the majority of the electors thereon.
