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Governor Kelly Places First Legal Sports Bet in Kansas

Laura Kelly traveled to Hollywood Casino in Kansas City, Kansas to kick off legal sports betting in Kansas. The Governor placed the first legal sports wager in Kansas, betting \$15 – the same as Patrick Mahomes’ jersey number – on the Kansas City Chiefs to win Super Bowl LVII this upcoming football season.

“Every day I hear from Kansans across the state who are eager to finally place legal wagers on sports. I’m glad we were able to move quickly to get this bipartisan effort done in time for football season,” Governor Laura Kelly said. “Now, casinos, restaurants, and other venues will have another way to attract Kansans to their establishments—creating jobs and driving economic growth. And I’m willing to bet on that. Go Chiefs!”

“We are so grateful for the leadership of Governor Kelly and the legislature to finally get legalized sports wagering over the goal line this year,” said Lydia Garvey, Vice President and General Manager of Hollywood Casino at Kansas Speedway. “We have been waiting anxiously for this day to arrive, and I’m confident many of our customers will follow her lead in betting on Kansas City to emerge as champions once again.”

The four casinos contracted with the state to offer sports wagering through independent platforms are Boot Hill Casino & Resort; Ford County near Dodge City; Kansas Star Casino in Mulvane; Hollywood Casino at Kansas Speedway, Kansas City, KS; and Kansas Crossing Casino & Hotel in Pittsburg.?

Tribal casinos are also working to align on contracts with the State of Kansas for sports wagering. These casinos will be authorized to launch as soon as they are ready.

Police officer warns about financial fraud

When Jason Vaughn became the detective assigned to financial crimes for the Kansas City, Kansas, Police Department, he had a backlog of about nine months of cases. As of late August, that caseload has been reduced to about 1.5 months.

Vaughn spoke to members of the West Patrol Police Advisory Committee at its monthly meeting Thursday, Aug. 25.

Vaughn said there are many scams that rob people of their money. He told the story of a scam artist who tells a person he or she has won money, but needs a bank account number to send the money. Other frauds include the “sweetheart scam” that preys on lonely single persons; the scammer will lure a person into believing he or she needs money.

Vaughn said other scam artists will use to telephone

to threaten cutting off BPU service unless a bill is paid immediately.

Vaughn encouraged persons to report information about any fraudulent financial crime. He can be reached at 913-573-6028.

In other matters, Major Dustin Dungan, the West Patrol Commander, said the number of homicides for Kansas City, Kansas, for 2022 is down at 28 compared to 33 for the same period during 2021. He said there has been an officer who has been assigned to the Legends Outlet.

Some 15 to 20 vehicles at the Legends Outlet were burglarized Sunday afternoon Aug. 28. Police located a suspect vehicle near 98th Street and Parallel Parkway and a chase ended in the 8400 block of Kansas Avenue. Two suspects were apprehended. Citizens helped by providing descriptions of the stolen

vehicle.

Major Dungan said the Police Department is about 40 officers short of its authorized strength of 369. There is also a critical shortage of dispatchers, Major Dungan said; there was only one dispatcher during a recent weekend. There should have been four dispatchers during this period. Major Dungan blamed the residency requirement on this shortage.

The Police and Sheriff’s departments will combine for a family day celebration from 10 a.m. until 1 p.m. Saturday, Sept. 17 at Piper Creek Elementary School, 13021 Leavenworth Rd. Those attending will be able to visit with officers and see vehicle and equipment displays. Field games will be offered. A complimentary lunch will be served.

AG Derek Schmidt: States Need Authority to Hold Airlines Accountable

TOPEKA – Kansas Attorney General Derek Schmidt today asked congressional leaders to enact legislation that will give states greater authority to investigate customer complaints against airlines as the nation sees a dramatic rise in passenger dissatisfaction.

In a letter signed by Schmidt and 37 other state and territory attorneys general, Schmidt asked Congress to pass a law removing federal restrictions that give central jurisdiction to investigate and prosecute airline complaints to the U.S. Department of Transportation. Schmidt and the other attorneys general argue that states have robust consumer protection units and, if the federal preemption were removed, could help ensure passengers are treated fairly by the airlines.

“The mistreatment of airline consumers is a bi-partisan issue — one that requires immediate action from federal lawmakers,” the attorneys general wrote. “Flying is essential to millions of Americans as they go about their personal and professional lives and is critical to our local, state, and national economies. Customers booking airline tickets should enjoy a reasonable expectation of being treated fairly, respectfully, and consistently under the law throughout all interactions during their experience with the airline industry. Consumer confidence in the air travel experience is paramount to a thriving economy.”

The letter urges Congress to pass legislation that would authorize state attorneys general to enforce both state and federal consumer protection laws governing the airline industry. It also encourages Congress to consider shifting the authority for federal investigations of airline patron complaints from the U.S. Department of Transportation to an agency more primarily focused on consumer protection, such as the U.S. Department of Justice or the Federal Trade Commission.

REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS

On or after September 19, 2022, the Unified Government of Wyandotte County/ Kansas City, KS will submit a request to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the release of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds under Title 1, Section 104(f) of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, P.L. 93-383, as amended, to undertake the following project:

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG)

Project Title: Home Repair Program

Purpose: The Unified Government of Wyandotte County/ Kansas City, KS operates a city-wide home repair program to assist eligible participants with the rehab or repair of emergency conditions at owner-occupied single-family homes that pose a serious threat to homeowner, neighbors or the general public. The program provides repair or replacement of failed primary systems including furnace replacement, upgrading faulty electrical systems, leaky roofs, sewer and septic systems and water service lines. The project also includes a barrier removal program to assist low-income disabled residents with projects designed to remove architectural barriers and increase accessibility to and within their homes. Emergency items cannot exceed \$8000 and if the repairs exceed \$8000, a Forgivable Mortgage, Promissory Note or LURA may be imposed on the property. With 2022-2023 funding, approximately 100 projects per year will be completed with funds over a 1-year period. The project boundary is Kansas City, KS. The review will use tiering, and Tier-II reviews will be completed once addresses are known.

Location: City-Wide

Estimated Cost: The estimated HUD funding and total project cost amount is \$500,000.00

HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIP PROGRAMS (HOME)

Project Title: CHDO Activities – New Construction and Rehabilitation

Purpose: The Unified Government of Wyandotte County and Kansas City, KS plans to use HUD fund to construct and/or rehabilitate single-family homes using scattered site infill construction development through Community Development Housing Organizations (CHDO) agency partners. CHDO include but are not limited to: Habitat for Humanity, Community Housing of Wyandotte County (CHWC), St. Benedict's, St. Margaret's, Mt Carmel Development Corporation, (MCDC), etc. With 2022-2023 funding, up to 6 homes will be constructed each year over a 1-year period (2022-2023). These activities will take place in urban, residential areas in Kansas City, KS. Work will be done to Energy Star requirements. The project activities may include ground disturbance. Acquisition is sometimes a project activity. As project sites are determined, site-specific Tiered II entries will be made.

The Unified Government of Wyandotte County/ Kansas City, KS certifies to HUD that Tyrone Garner in his capacity as Mayor/CEO consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. HUD will accept objections to its release of fund and the Unified Government of Wyandotte County/ Kansas City, KS certification for a period of fifteen days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of the Unified Government of Wyandotte County/ Kansas City, KS; (b) the Unified Government of Wyandotte County/ Kansas City, KS has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other participants in the development process have committed funds, incurred costs or undertaken activities not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by HUD; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58, Sec. 58.76) and shall be addressed to U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, Region VII. Governor Urges Kansas Small Businesses to Prepare for COVID-19 Retail Storefront Property Tax Relief Program

TOPEKA – Governor Laura Kelly announced that her administration is launching the application process for the COVID-19 Retail Storefront Property Tax Relief program in October. She urged Kansas small business owners to verify they are registered for a federal Unique Entity Identifier (UEI) ahead of the application process opening.

“The financial assistance provided through this program will give Kansas entrepreneurs resources to continue to grow and invest in their businesses,” said Governor Laura Kelly. “Proactively verifying UEI registration will help small business owners receive this relief quickly and efficiently once the program’s application portal opens in October.”

In June, Governor Kelly signed bipartisan House Bill 2136, investing \$50 million to help small businesses recover from the COVID-19 pandemic.

The COVID-19 Retail Storefront Property Tax Relief Program is funded through the federal American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), which requires a UEI registration to be completed for a business to be eligible to receive assistance. UEI registration ensures the accuracy of information and the security of funding being used for this program.

The UEI is a unique 12-character identifier assigned to all entities and is used as the primary means of entity identification for Federal awards and for those doing business with the federal government. The UEI is issued at no cost through the federal System for Award Management website (SAM.gov).

If a business is already registered in SAM.gov, no additional action is needed to obtain a UEI. UEI registration can be confirmed by logging into SAM.gov and verifying that the business’ Entity Status states “Active Registration.”

Please note that due to recent increases in the number of entities registering with SAM.gov it may take up to 25 business days for new registrations to be processed. For any issues related to registering with SAM.gov or obtaining a UEI the Federal Service Desk can be reached at 866-606-8220.

Information detailing the application process and dates for the COVID-19 Retail Storefront Property Tax Relief Program is forthcoming from the Kansas Department of Revenue. The application will provide definitions, explain the assistance process in detail, and will specify exactly what information must be submitted in support of the application.

Claimants will have until April 15, 2023, to file an application for this financial assistance.

Total August Tax Receipts \$23.5M More Than 2021

TOPEKA – Governor Laura Kelly announced that Kansas’ August total tax receipts were \$652.5 million. Those receipts were \$11.2 million more than the estimate and \$23.5 million, or 3.7%, more than August 2021.

“It is because of strong revenues and fiscal responsibility that we have been able to cut property and grocery taxes, strengthen infrastructure, fund law enforcement, and fully fund public education,” said Governor Laura Kelly. “For the 25th consecutive month, we have met or exceeded the revenue estimate, showing that we are providing businesses a stable economic environment to grow and succeed.”

Individual income tax collections were \$307.3 million, or 2.4%, more than the estimate. Corporate income tax collections were \$15.5 million, or 3.1%, more than the estimate.

August retail sales tax collections were \$239.6 million, or 1.9%, greater than the estimate. This amount is also \$13.1 million, or 5.8%, greater than August 2021. Compensating use tax collections were \$63.3 million, which is \$1.7 million less than the estimate, but 8.2%, or \$4.8 million, greater than August 2021. When viewed in the aggregate, sales and compensating use tax receipts are \$17.9 million, or 6.3%, greater than August 2021.
