Bivalent COVID Boosters Are Coming to Wyandotte County

The UG Public Health Department Will Offer the New Bivalent COVID Boosters Beginning the Week of September 19

Beginning the week of September 19, 2022, the new bivalent COVID boosters will be available for eligible individuals ages 12 and older at the Unified Government Public Health Department (UGPHD), 619 Ann Ave, Kansas City, KS, 66101.

The new Pfizer and Moderna boosters are “bivalent,” meaning they protect against both the original virus that causes COVID as well as the Omicron BA.4 and BA.5 variants of the virus (the variants responsible for most recent COVID cases).

The bivalent booster is available for people ages 12

and older who have completed the primary vaccination series and received their most recent COVID vaccine or booster at least 2 months ago.

COVID vaccines and boosters are available at the UGPHD by appointment only. Call 913-573-8815 to make an appointment.

The Unified Government of Wyandotte County Public Health Department (UGPHD) announced that it will provide the new COVID bivalent boosters by appointment beginning the week of September 19, 2022. Patients can call 913-573-8815 to make an appointment.

This follows Federal Drug Administration (FDA) authorization and recommendations from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE). The new Pfizer and Moderna boosters are “bivalent,” meaning they protect against both the original virus that causes COVID as well as the Omicron BA.4 and BA.5 variants of the virus.

The CDC, KDHE, and UGPHD recommend that everyone who is eligible get the new bivalent booster to stay up-to-date on their vaccinations to get the best protection

against COVID. The Omicron BA.4 and BA.5 subvariants of the virus began increasing in May 2022, and they now account for almost all recent COVID cases in Kansas, Missouri, and the United States. They are predicted to continue circulating this fall and winter. These subvariants are more contagious than previous strains of the virus. While COVID vaccination and the old boosters still protect against serious illness or hospitalization, they offer limited protection against getting mild to moderate COVID illness from the Omicron BA.4 and BA.5 variants. The new bivalent COVID boosters, however, are made specifically to protect against these subvariants, in addition to continued protection against the original strain.

Under the updated Emer-

gency Use Authorizations (EUAs) from the FDA, the previous “monovalent” boosters (which did not have the same level of protection against Omicron) are no longer authorized for people ages 12 and older. For this reason, the UGPHD and other COVID vaccine providers have put booster appointments for people ages 12 and older on hold at this time until the new bivalent booster shipments arrive.

Who is eligible:

The bivalent COVID boosters are authorized for people ages 12 and older who have been vaccinated and received their most recent dose at least 2 months ago. This includes:

Individuals ages 12 and older who completed the primary series of COVID vaccinations at least 2 months ago, and have not yet received

a booster; and

Individuals ages 12 and older who completed the primary series and have received one or more doses of the previous monovalent COVID booster at least 2 months ago.

People ages 18 and older can receive either the Pfizer or the Moderna bivalent booster. People ages 12 to 17 can only receive the Pfizer bivalent booster at this time.

Please note that recommendations for children under age 12 have not changed. Children ages 6 months and older are eligible to receive a primary series of COVID vaccines. Some children ages 5 to 11 are eligible for the original monovalent booster (Pfizer only at this time).

Kelly Announces Five-Year, \$9M Grant to Improve Student Behavioral Health

Governor Kelly announced that Kansas has received \$9 million in funding from the U.S. Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) to address the behavioral health needs of nearly 40,000 students in the southeast part of the state.

“Ensuring students in every part of the state have access to quality mental and behavioral health services has been a top priority of my administration since Day One,” Governor Kelly said. “By leveraging SAMHSA funding, we’re giving kids in Southeast Kansas the tools they need to navigate their unique challenges now and into the future.”

The funding will be spread out over five years and will

be administered through the Department of Pediatrics at KU School of Medicine to fund KanAWARE, a coalition of state and nonprofit organizations that works to address student behavioral health needs in the southeast Kansas corridor. With this grant, KanAWARE will integrate school-based community health workers into its behavioral health support system for students and families in need.

“We are excited to be part of the coalition of agencies working on this grant project,” said Andy Brown, Behavioral Health Services Commissioner for the Kansas Department for Aging and Disability Services (KDADS). “This project will help establish a sustainable infrastructure for

promoting behavioral health in schools.”

KanAWARE is an expansion of Telehealth Rural Outreach for the Children of Kansas (Telehealth ROCKS), an internet-based delivery service model to address the health disparities faced by rural children.

“We have never faced a time of greater student behavioral health needs, matched with community innovation to meet these needs,” said Dr. Evelyn Nelson, KanAWARE principal investigator. “Our Telehealth ROCKS team and partners are grateful for KanAWARE funding to extend our strongest, evidence-supported behavioral health strategies and to set students up for success now and in the future.”

AN ORDINANCE EXPRESSING THE PROPERTY TAXATION POLICY OF THE UNIFIED GOVERNMENT OF WYANDOTTE COUNTY/KANSAS CITY, KANSAS WITH RESPECT TO FINANCING THE 2023 ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE SELF-SUPPORTED MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT AND APPROVING, ADOPTING AND APPROPRIATING THE BUDGET OF THE SELF-SUPPORTED MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT AND LEVYING A TAX FOR THE YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2023.

WHEREAS, on July 28, 2016, pursuant to Ordinance 0-52-16 the Downtown Kansas City, Kansas Self-Supported Municipal Improvement District (the "District") was established; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 0-52-16 also established a maximum mill levy rate of 13.301 mills for the District; and

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO SEWER SERVICE CHARGES, APPROVING THE REGULATION ESTABLISHING THE RATE, EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2023, AS AUTHORIZED BY SECTION 30-96 OF THE CODE OF THE UNIFIED GOVERNMENT OF WYANDOTTE COUNTY/KANSAS CITY, KANSAS, AND REPEALING ANY PREVIOUSLY ADOPTED REGULATIONS ESTABLISHING SUCH RATES.

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Unified Government of Wyandotte County/Kansas City, Kansas has determined as part of the projected annual budget that sewer service charges are required to be increased by five percent effective January 1, 2023; and

WHEREAS, Section 30-96 of the Code of the Unified Government of Wyandotte County/ Kansas City, Kansas provides that the Board of Commissioners shall establish by regulation the rates for sewer charges necessary to ensure that the system generates adequate annual revenues to pay the annual costs of operation and maintenance, to satisfy costs associated with any obligations, and to provide for costs associated with the Unified Government capital improvement plan and the expenses of the annual operation of the Water Pollution Control Division for providing services; and

ORDINANCE NO. O-130-22

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE MONTHLY FEE ON RESIDENTIAL UNITS IN THE CITY OF KANSAS CITY, KANSAS, TO FUND THE UNIFIED GOVERNMENT'S SOLID WASTE SERVICES, AMENDING SECTION 31-17(b) OF THE UNIFIED GOVERNMENT OF WYANDOTTE COUNTY/KANSAS CITY, KANSAS CODE AND REPEALING ORIGINAL SECTION 31-17(b).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE UNIFIED GOVERNMENT OF WYANDOTTE COUNTY/KANSAS CITY, KANSAS:

Section 1. That Section 31-17(b) of the Unified Government of Wyandotte County/Kansas City, Kansas Code be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 31-17. Service Fee. (b) Levy and payment of fee and effective date.

1) Effective January 1, 2015, a monthly solid waste fee in the amount of \$15.40 is hereby levied on all single-family residences and all residential units in buildings containing not more than four dwelling units in the City.
