First Report Shows Kansas Child Welfare System Making Significant Progress

TOPEKA – Kansas foster children have stable placements and are experiencing fewer moves while in care, according to the first report from the Neutral Third Party in the McIntyre class action lawsuit settlement.

“My administration inherited a broken child welfare system that had an unacceptable number of children in care, a lack of placement stability, and limited prevention services,” Governor Laura Kelly said. “Under my Administration, we now have 1,300 fewer children in the system, and the Neutral Report shows we have made substantial progress in making sure kids are in stable

placements and experience fewer moves. There’s more work to be done, but this report shows we are headed in the right direction.”

The McIntyre class action lawsuit was filed in 2018 under the Colyer Administration by Kansas Appleseed, Children’s Rights, and the National Center for Youth Law against the Governor, Kansas Department for Children and Families, Kansas Department for Aging and Disability Services, and the Kansas Department of Health and Environment. The Governor was later dismissed from the case.

The parties agreed to a settlement in 2020. The set-

tlement was structured to ensure Kansas would achieve substantial progress and compliance in key performance areas over a multi-year period. Performance areas include accountability, reporting and implementation, practice improvements and outcomes. The settlement recognizes that the outcomes and practice improvements will not all be accomplished in one year. Outcome goals were set for a three-to-four-year period.

Judith Meltzer, President of the Center for the Study of Social Policy serves as the Neutral Third Party responsible for assessing the State’s first year progress. This first report covers calendar 2021.

“Reforming a child welfare system is a complex and multi-year endeavor,” Meltzer said. “During this first year, Kansas has made considerable progress in addressing some fundamental problems and has started down a path that we anticipate will lead to further improvements in the years ahead and to sustainable and meaningful improvements for Kansas children and families.”

Kansas made significant progress in placement stability. The Neutral validated that Kansas achieved its first-year benchmarks for placement stability and placement moves. Children in care experienced a rate of 5.84 moves per 1,000 days – more than meeting the benchmark of seven moves per 1,000 days. The report also shows that 86% of Kansas kids were in stable placements during CY 21, surpassing the benchmark of 80%.

“The report affirms our commitment to Kansas children by continuing efforts to build an effective child welfare system,” DCF Secretary Laura Howard said. “Using tools like kinship placements, partnerships with community agencies to provide trauma-informed support to

foster parents and prioritizing families over facilities, these have all had a positive impact on this issue.”

The state does have more work to do in both temporary overnight placements and night-to-night or short-term placements. Children who experience a failure to place often have complex developmental, medical, behavioral or safety needs.

DCF is working to build capacity through several new initiatives. The agency has created the Failure to Place Prevention Network with the goal of creating stand-by service beds and other ways for family foster home to serve one child at a time. DCF also is addressing gaps with the addition of Therapeutic Foster Homes that launched in 2022.

The report also shows Kansas achieved several accountability benchmarks mandated by the agreement. Those include:

- Amending case management provider contracts to clarify responsibilities arising from the settlement
- Creating an independent advisory group to inform planning and program improvement

• Collecting and reporting data on Class Members placed in a jail, correctional or detention facility

State agencies also are making significant progress in mental health practice improvements and outcomes despite not reaching the CY 21 benchmarks.

• DCF approved a contract with Beacon Health Options to create the Mobile Family Crisis Helpline which launched in Oct. of 2021.

• Unvalidated period 2 data shows significant improvement in addressing mental and behavioral health needs with nearly 80% of Class Members having their needs met.

“Addressing mental and behavioral health needs is vital if we are to have a strong child and family well-being system,” Howard said. “We know there is more work to do to strengthen the timely and consistent access to mental health assessments and reviews.”

DCF and its partner agencies will continue to collaborate with the Center for the Study of Social Policy to ensure valid data and look forward to showing more progress in the Period 2 report in 2023.

Kansas Hits 10 Straight Months of Record-Low Unemployment

TOPEKA – Governor Laura Kelly celebrated that for the past ten months, Kansas’ unemployment rate has been below 2.9% -- the previous historic low last reached in August 1978. For each of those months, Kansas’ unemployment rate was over a full percentage point below the nation’s unemployment rate.

According to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics, Kansas has the 8th lowest unemployment rate in the country.

“We have been tireless about prioritizing job creation, business investment, and workforce development – and it’s clear our efforts are paying off,” said Governor Kelly. “For ten straight months, Kansas has far outstripped the nation as a whole when it comes to ensuring people have the high-quality employment they need to provide for their families and contribute to their communities.”

This month, Governor Kelly announced that Kansas has surpassed 50,000 jobs created and retained since the start of her administration.

Kansas began keeping records of monthly unemployment rates in January 1976.

WHEREAS, Section 25-2708(b) also provides that "If the election of any officer . . . at such time is being contested, the ballots shall not be destroyed until such contest is finally decided."; and

WHEREAS, An election contest was filed following the 2021 general election in Wyandotte County, contesting the races for sheriff, the at-large district 2 commissioner, the district 1 commissioner, and an at-large member of the Board of Public Utilities, and such contest now lies with the Kansas Supreme Court on appeal; and

WHEREAS, Another provision, K.S.A. 25-2708(d), provides that "Other election supplies, books, records, lists and papers shall be destroyed as provided by law."; and

WHEREAS, Finally, another section, K.S.A. 25-2709, describes various election materials and permits their destruction upon the expiration of their respective retention periods, those periods varying from two years to five years to 20 years;

Project includes engineering studies and design as well as construction of improvements to address the Metropolitan Avenue drainage issues, a pipe outfall near 10th Street, mitigating icy conditions caused by a natural spring near 12th Street and Ruby Avenue, and add additional pipe and inlet capacity. Exact nature of construction improvements is unknown at this time.

3. Jersey Creek Basin Stormwater Improvements - Stormwater Im-

provements to be located within the Jersey Creek watershed, upstream of a piped (concrete box) section that empties into the Missouri River. Improvements include reduction of peak flow flooding by removing the concrete lined channel and restoring the area to a stabilized natural channel, constructing flood benches, adjacent green infrastructure components, and modification of existing stormwater infrastructure to accommodate the project work.

4. Wyandotte High Lombardy Drive Stormwater Improvements - Expand and create new stormwater management facilities along Lombardy Drive and 22nd Street north of Taunomee Ave. Three green infrastructure locations have been identified in low lying area east of Lombardy Drive, a ravine south of Lombardy drive and east of 22nd street, and a ravine south of Taunomee and west of 22nd street. Work includes design and construction of rain gardens (water retention basins), bioswales, planters, and other similar improvements to reduce stormwater runoff the amount entering the combined sanitary sewer system.

5. Eighth Street Park Stormwater Improvements - The design and reconstruction of Eighth Street Park to include green infrastructure and sewer separation to address stormwater runoff in a combined sewer overflow area. This project is within the Splitlog drainage basin which the second largest annual overflow of approximately 180MG. The Juvenile Justice Center was constructed in this sensitive area and continues to need stormwater mitigation. This project is anticipated to mitigate approximately 1.25 ac-ft stormwater runoff storage which is 25% higher than the anticipated target based upon preliminary designs. The design is to include park amenities such as open pond and soccer fields that would be inclusive to the retention and detention functionality of the stormwater system.

6. Stormwater Renewal & Replacement - The maintenance and replacement of stormwater assets that have failed or are preparing to fail in the stormwater infrastructure system. 2400 locations have been identified at this time. Work will be prioritized to locations requiring emergency repairs and failures, followed by an improvement plan developed to prioritize locations based on need and greatest impact. Renewal and replacement program includes improvements such as cured-in-place pipe lining, point repairs to pipes, full replacement of pipes, manhole or inlet repair/replacement, soil replacement and stabilization at pipe outlets and along streams, soil and other similar activities. This funding will augment the WIFIA projects: Argentine Basin Stormwater Improvements, Jersey Creek Basin Stormwater Improvements, Muncie Creek Basin Stormwater Improvements, and Wyandotte High Lombardy Drive.

7. Muncie Creek Basin Stormwater Improvements - Stormwater Improvements to be located south of Kaw Valley Scenic Highway and west of the Kansas River. Improvements include addressing drainage issues along Speaker Road, Royal Drive, and South 59th Lane by replacing outfalls and upsizing the maximum pipe diameter to 60-inch RCP in the area. The Speaker Road improvements include extending the stormwater network north for approx. 985 feet with 48" RCP, removing sediment deposits and grading.

8. Census Tract 422 Clifton Park Green Infrastructure - This project will address areas sensitive to regulatory oversight within a combined sewer area to capture and treat stormwater runoff through the implementation of green infrastructure. The project locations will be specified in the final design

but will expand the existing storm system on Park Drive, a neighborhood connection between Central Ave and 1-70. The expansion is to include curb extensions, rain gardens, dry creek beds, and vegetated extensions to build a green infrastructure network to address and mitigate stormwater runoff.
