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2023 Medicare Open Enrollment Begins October 15

TOPEKA – More than 540,000 Kansas residents receive health coverage through Medicare, and the time to review benefits is only days away. The program's fall open enrollment period, when you can make changes that take effect January 1, starts October 15, 2002 and runs through December 7, 2022

"It's important that older adults make sure their current providers are still participating in their plan for 2023 and that the cost of any medications they need haven't increased," KDADS Medicare Program Manager Emily Blanch said. "Medicare beneficiaries can make changes to several aspects of their coverage and take the time to weigh all the coverage options available to them from various insurers. We encourage people to always take advantage of this time as all of us have health care needs that change over the course of a year and Medicare plans change as well."

By shopping available plans and comparing costs, beneficiaries may be able to find a Medicare health or drug plan with better coverage or a lower premium in 2023. The Medicare Plan Finder allows users to compare pricing between Original Medicare,

Medicare prescription drug plans, Medicare Advantage plans, and Medicare Supplement Insurance (Medigap) policies.

During open enrollment, those currently enrolled may: • Switch from original Medicare to Medicare Ad-

vantage, or vice versa · Switch from one Medicare Advantage plan to another or from one Medicare Part D prescription drug plan to another

• If you didn't enroll in a Medicare Part D plan when you were first eligible, you can do so during open enrollment, although a late enrollment penalty may apply

If you want to enroll in a Medicare Advantage plan, vou must meet some basic criteria:


• You must be enrolled in Medicare Part A and B

• You must live in the plan's service area

If you're already enrolled in a Medicare Part D prescription plan or a Medicare Advantage Plan and you don't want to make changes to your coverage for 2023, you don't need to do anything during open enrollment, assuming your current plan will still be available in 2023. If your plan is being discontinued and isn't eligible for renewal, you will receive a non-renewal notice from your carrier prior to open enrollment. If you don't, it means you can keep your plan without doing anything during open enrollment.

Be aware that benefits and premiums could be changing for 2023. So even if you're confident you want to keep your current coverage for the coming year, it's important to understand any changes that may apply and check to make sure your current plan is still the best available option. The available plans and what they cover change from one year to the next, so even if the plan you have now was the best option when you shopped last year, it's important to verify that again before you lock yourself in for another year.

Each year, there's a Medicare Advantage Open Enrollment Period from January 1 - March 31. During this time, if you're in a Medicare Advantage Plan and want to change your health plan. you can switch to a different Medicare Advantage Plan with or without drug coverage or go back to original Medicare and, if needed, also



join a Medicare Prescription Drug Plan.

Changes to be aware of for 2023 include:

• There are 90 Medicare Advantage plans available in 2023, compared to 88 plans in 2022.

• 100 percent of people with Medicare have access to a Medicare Advantage plan.

• The average monthly Medicare Advantage plan premium saw a -20.6 percent change, from \$7.77 in 2022 to \$6.17 in 2023.

• 23 Medicare prescription drug plans are available with premiums varying from \$2.80 to \$112.60.

• 100 percent of people with a stand-alone Medicare prescription drug plan have access to a plan with a lower premium than what they paid in 2022.

• Through the CMS Innovation Center's Value-Based Insurance Design (VBID) Model, 20 plans will offer Medicare Advantage enrollees additional options, including reductions in cost sharing for certain covered benefits, such as eliminated Medicare Part D cost sharing: rewards and incentives programs related to healthy behaviors; and customized, innovative benefits that address social determinants of health, such as food insecurity and social isolation, for enrollees who receive low income subsidies and/ or chronically ill enrollees.

Items that cannot be accepted include:



A PROPOSITION to amend article 1 of the constitution of the state of Kansas by adding a new section thereto, concerning oversight by the legislature of certain executive branch actions.

Be it resolved by the Legislature of the State of Kansas, two-thirds of the members elected (or appointed) and qualified to the House of Representatives and two-thirds of the members elected (or appointed) and qualified to the Senate concurring therein.

Section 1. The following proposition to amend the constitution of the state of Kansas shall be submitted to the qualified electors of the state for their approval or rejection: Article 1 of the constitution of the state of Kansas is hereby amended by adding a new section to read as

follows: "§ 17. Legislative oversight of administrative rules and regulations.

Whenever the legislature by law has authorized any officer or agency within the executive branch of government to adopt rules and regulations that have the force and effect of law, the legislature may provide by law for the revocation or suspension of any such rule and regulation, or any portion thereof, upon a vote of a majority of the members then elected or appointed and qualified in each house.³

Sec. 2. The following statement shall be printed on the ballot with the amendment as a whole:

- "Explanatory statement. The purpose of this amendment is to provide the legislature with oversight of state executive branch agencies and officials by providing the legislature authority to establish procedures to revoke or suspend rules and regulations.
- 'A vote for this proposition would allow the legislature to establish procedures to revoke or suspend rules and regulations that are adopted by state executive branch agencies and officials that have the force and effect of law.
- 'A vote against this proposition would allow state executive branch agencies and officials to continue adopting rules and regulations that have the force and effect of law without any opportunity for the legislature to directly revoke or suspend such rules and regulations."

Sec. 3. This resolution, if approved by two-thirds of the members elected (or appointed) and qualified to the House of Representatives and two-thirds of the members elected (or appointed) and qualified to the Senate, shall be entered on the journals, together with the yeas and nays. The secretary of state shall cause this resolution to be published as provided by law and shall cause the proposed amendment to be submitted to the electors of the state at the general election in the year 2022, unless a special election is called at a sooner date by concurrent resolution of the legislature, in which case it shall be submitted to the electors of the state at the special election.

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION No. 5022

"§ 2. County and township officers. (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), each county shall elect a sheriff for a term of four years by a majority of the qualified electors of the county voting thereon at the time of voting designated for such office pursuant to law in effect on January 11, 2022, and every four years thereafter.

(b) The provisions of subsection (a) shall not apply to a county that abolished the office of sheriff prior to January 11, 2022. Such county may restore the office of sheriff as provided by law and such restoration shall be irrevocable. A county that restores the office of sheriff shall elect a sheriff by a majority of the qualified electors of the county voting thereon for a term of four years. Such sheriff shall have such qualifications and duties as provided by law. The time of voting for the office of sheriff may be provided for by the legislature pursuant to section 18 of article 2 of this constitution.

(c) The filling of vacancies and the qualifications and duties of the office of sheriff shall be as provided by law.

(d) The legislature shall provide for such other county and township officers as may be necessary.

"§ 5. Removal of officers. (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), all county and township officers may be removed from office, in such manner and for such cause, as shall be prescribed by law.

(b) A county sheriff only may be involuntarily removed from office by recall election pursuant to section 3 of article 4 of this constitution or a writ of quo warranto initiated by the attorney general."

Sec. 2. The following statement shall be printed on the ballot with the amendment as a whole:

- "Explanatory statement. This amendment would preserve the right of citizens of each county that elected a county sheriff as of January 11, 2022, to continue electing the county sheriff. The amendment would also provide that a county sheriff only may be involuntarily removed from office pursuant to either a recall election or a writ of quo warranto initiated by the attorney general.
- "A vote for this proposition would preserve the right of citizens of each county that elected a county sheriff as of January 11, 2022, to continue electing the county sheriff via popular vote. The amendment would also direct that a county sheriff only may be involuntarily removed from office pursuant to either a recall election or a writ of quo warranto initiated by the attorney general.
- "A vote against this proposition would not make any changes to the constitution and would retain current law concerning the election of a sheriff and the procedures for involuntary removal of a sheriff from office

This resolution, if approved by two-thirds of the members elected (or appointed) and qualified to the House of Representatives and two-thirds of the members elected (or appointed) and qualified to the Senate, shall be entered on the journals, together with the yeas and nays. An ordinance relating to Chap-ter 22 Miscellaneous Provisions and Offenses, Article IV Offenses Against Public Peace, adding new Section 22-129; Operation of Unmanned Aerial Vehicles, of the Code of Ordinances for the Unified Government of Wyandotte County/Kansas City, Kansas

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE UNIFIED GOVERN MENT OF WYANDOTTE COUN-TY/KANSAS CITY, KANSAS:

Section 1. That Chapter 22 Miscellaneous Provisions and Offenses, Article IV Offenses Against Public Peace, adding new Section 22-129. Operation of Unmanned Aerial Vehicles of the Code of Ordinances for the Unified Government of Wyandotte County/Kansas City, Kansas, to read as follows:

Sec. 22-129. - Operation of Unmanned Aerial Vehicles

(a) Definitions. For purposes of this article, the following terms and phrases shall have the meaning set forth below:

City airspace means the airspace above the land and waterways within the jurisdiction of the city.

Recreational purposes means any purposes governed or reg-ulated pursuant to 49 U.S.C. 44809 (Section 349) of the FAA Reauthorization Act of 2018 'Recreational purposes" may include, but are not limited to, enjoyment, educational, or hobby purposes not otherwise governed or regulated as provided in subsection (c) Limitations on Operating Regulations of this section.

Operate means to pilot, steer, direct, fly or manage a UAV through the air. The term "operate" includes managing or initiating a computer system that pilots, steers, directs, flies or manages a UAV.

Unmanned aerial vehicle or UAV means an aircraft that: (1) is operated without the possibility of direct human intervention from within or on the aircraft, and (2) weighs less than 55 pounds at the time of operation, including the weight of any payload or fuel.

Weapon means any instrument, article or substance that, under the circumstances in which it is used, attempted to be used or threatened to be used, is readily capable of causing death or serious physical injury.

(b) Operating Regulations. Except as otherwise provided in subsection (c) and unless any of the following prohibitions are superseded by applicable state or Federal law, no person shall operate any UAV for recreational purposes in city airspace:

(1) Intentionally or negligently, and in such proximity to any person who is not involved in

the operation of the UAV that is offensive to a reasonable expectation of safety from bodily harm, without such person's consent;

(2) Intentionally or negligently, over an individual or over an open-air event venue wherein more than 100 individuals are gathered for such event, without the consent of both the venue owner or operator and the event sponsor or organizer;

(3) Intentionally or negligently, over property that the operator does not own, without the consent of the property owner or such other person lawfully occupying the property; and subject to any restrictions that may be placed on the operation by the property owner or such other person lawfully occupying the property; provided, that the foregoing shall not prohibit operation of a UAV for recreational or hobby purposes in a city-owned park so long as the operator and UAV comply with all other requirements and re-strictions of this section, Federal and State law;

(4) While under the influence of alcohol, or other drug or drugs, that renders the operator incapable of operating the UAV; (5) That is equipped with a

firearm or other weapon; or (6) Otherwise in a reckless or

careless manner. (c) Limitations on Operating Regulations.

(1) Commercial Operations Authorized by the FAA. Notwith-standing the provisions of section 22-129(b), nothing in this article shall be construed to prohibit, limit or otherwise restrict any person who is authorized to fly a UAV as a commercial pilot pursuant to 14 CFR Part 107 (drones under 55 pounds) or under the Special Authority for Certain Unmanned Aircraft Systems at 49 USC § 44807 (drones over 55 pounds) by or other Federal Aviation Administration grant of authority for a specific flight operation(s), from conducting such operations(s) in accordance with authority granted by the Federal Aviation Administration.

(2) Operations Prohibited by FAA—Clarification. Nothing in this Article shall be construed to authorize the operation of UAVs in city airspace in violation of any Federal statute or rules promulgated thereunder, including, but not limited to, any temporary flight restrictions or notices to airmen issued by the Federal Aviation Administration.

(3) Operations by City. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 22-129(b), nothing in this article shall be construed to prohibit or restrict the use of a UAV by law enforcement, fire department, or Unified Government employees or for other emergency response operations in accordance with applicable law.

(d) Severability.

Severability is intended throughout and within the provisions of this Section. If any subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this article is held to be invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then that decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this article.

(e) Penalty. Violation of this Section is a

ORDINANCE NO. 0-145-22

AN ORDINANCE relating to Chapter 3, Air Pollution, amending Section 3-22 of the Unified Government Code.

WHEREAS, the Wyandotte County Health Department is responsible for monitoring air pollution and responding to possible violations of the Unified Government Code; and

WHEREAS, the specific instru-ment referenced in Sec. 3-22 of the Unified Government Code is no longer being manufactured; and WHEREAS, the Wyandotte County Health Department and Kansas Department of Health and Environment have found a comparable instrument to measure

odorous emissions. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE UNIFIED GOVERNMENT OF WYANDOTTE COUNTY/KANSAS CITY KANSAS.

Section 1. That Chapter 3, Air Pollution, Section 3-22, of the Code of Ordinances for the Unified Government of Wyandotte County/Kansas City, Kansas, be amended to read as follows:

Sec. 3-22. Restriction of emission of odors. (a) No person shall cause or

permit odorous emissions so as to cause air pollution.

(b) An odor occurrence shall be deemed a violation when a complaint from one person or more is received and substantiated at the point of complaint within one business day by observations of the director or their designee.
