Holiday tips for helping fight financial fraud

Topeka, Kan. – 'Tis the season for giving, which means you should be on high alert for bad actors. In 2020, Kansans ages 60 and up fell victim to financial fraud to the tune of \$48 million. Making fraud prevention a family affair is one of the most effective ways to stop bad actors in their tracks.

"Families are often the first line of defense against bad actors," said Insurance Commissioner Vicki Schmidt. "New tactics and scams are constantly being deployed by fraudsters, especially during the holiday season.

Here are several family-focused fraud prevention tips to consider when helping loved ones protect their pocketbooks:

- Check in often – Regular communication with your elderly loved ones is the best way to detect behavior changes that could indicate if someone has gained unwarranted influence over their investment and financial decision-making.
- Do not shame – We have all been tricked before, and victims of fraud should be comforted when coping with the fallout of deceptive actions. Keeping an empathetic tone when dealing with fraud will increase the victim's willingness to open up about the experience.
- Encourage verification – Encourage loved ones excited about a new investment opportunity to inquire about the registration status of the individual selling the investment. Not all investments sold require the entity or individual to be registered, but investment opportunities not backed by a registered entity or person deserve additional scrutiny.

Keep Your Pets Safe This Holiday Season

The Humane Society of Missouri's Animal Medical Center of Mid-America shares important safety tips to keep pets merry and bright this holiday season

With the holiday season rapidly approaching, it's important to make sure your pets stay safe and healthy—especially with the temptations of new foods, decorations, and other potential hazards around that your pet might not be used to! The Humane Society of Missouri (HSMO) wishes you and your pets the warmest of wishes this holiday season. Below are a few tips from veterinarians at the HSMO's Animal Medical Center of Mid-America (AMCMA) to help ensure all celebrations are safe and fun for your four-legged friends:



Be Careful with Festive Foods

Food and drinks are a highlight of the holiday season, but they can pose dangers to your pet.

- Avoid feeding your pet anything they are not used to eating. Otherwise, they could end up with an upset stomach.
- Fatty and spicy foods, chocolate and other sweets, which can cause severe stomach issues, should be off-limits to pets.
- Don't give turkey, chicken or ham bones to your pet. Bones can easily break and splinter, causing mouth injuries and intestinal blockage.
- Move cocktails out of your pet's reach. Even though the impact of alcohol is often mild, call your veterinarian if your pet gets a hold of an alcoholic beverage. Be on the lookout for warning signs such as lethargy, drooling, vomiting or collapse.

Keep Seasonal Plants and Decorations Out of Reach

Ingesting any plant or decoration has the potential to cause vomiting, diarrhea, or gastrointestinal irritation. But some can be toxic to pets, so it is important to keep pets away from all decorations.

- Plants such as mistletoe, rosemary and holly berries can result in severe gastrointestinal upset if eaten.
- Christmas trees and other festive decorations can be dangerous to pets. If your pet chews on the lights or cords, they could be electrocuted. If ingested, decorations and tinsel could cause gastrointestinal problems or obstruction. Glass ornaments could pose an additional danger if your pet knocks them off the tree and the ornaments shatter.
- Live Christmas trees come with even more concerns. The oils from trees and tree needles can cause gastrointestinal trouble, and if pets eat the needles, those needles could puncture their intestinal lining. But the most dangerous part of the live tree is the water in the tree's base. The pine sap, preservatives and fire retardant in the water are harmful to dogs and cats.

Travel Safely and Secure Your Pet

If your holiday plans include driving, whether across the country or just across town to visit the dog park, your pet should be properly secured in the vehicle. If there were to be an accident and your pet isn't secure, they could suffer severe or life-threatening injuries.

- Small pets should be placed in a pet carrier during car rides, and the carrier needs to be securely fastened.
- Dogs should use a pet travel safety harness that attaches to your car's seat belt.
- Make sure your pet is always wearing their collar and identification tags, and if your pet is microchipped, verify that your contact information is current with the microchip company before you leave.

In case of any holiday pet emergency, make sure you have your veterinarian's contact information handy. The Animal Medical Center of Mid-America has veterinarians that can answer questions about your pet's health. Call 314.951.1534 or amcma.org to request an appointment online.



A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE STATE OF EMERGENCY FOR THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC FOR THE COUNTY OF WYANDOTTE, KANSAS, THROUGH MAY 1, 2023.

WHEREAS, on the 13th day of March, 2020, the Mayor/CEO of the Unified Government of Wyandotte County/ Kansas City, Kansas declared there was a state of local public disaster emergency in Wyandotte County, Kansas, resulting in potential or occurring pandemic known as COVID-19, in Wyandotte County, Kansas;

WHEREAS, on the 19th day of March, the Unified Government Commission adopted Resolution R-18-20 extending the state of local public health emergency through May 18, 2020;

WHEREAS, on the 14th day of May, 2020, the Unified Government Commission adopted Resolution R-30-20, extending the state of local public health emergency through July 17, 2020;

WHEREAS, on the 9th day of July, 2020, the Unified Government Commission adopted Resolution R-37-20, extending the state of local public health emergency through September 15, 2020;

WHEREAS, on the 3rd day of September, 2020, the Unified Government Commission adopted Resolution R-66-20, extending the state of local public health emergency through December 14, 2020;

WHEREAS, on the 3rd day of December, 2020, the Unified Government Commission adopted Resolution R-83-20, later corrected as Resolution R-83a-20 and published on February 4, 2021, extending the state of local public health emergency through March 15, 2021;

WHEREAS, on the 11th day of March, 2021, the Unified Government Commission adopted Resolution R-16-21 and published on March 18, 2021, extending the state of local public health emergency through June 15, 2021;

WHEREAS, on the 10th day of June, 2021, the Unified Government Commission adopted Resolution R-40-21 and published on June 17, 2021, extending the state of local public health emergency through September 15, 2021;

WHEREAS, on the 9th day of September, 2021, the Unified Government Commission adopted Resolution R-61-21 and published on September 16, 2021, extending the state of local public health emergency through December 16, 2021;

WHEREAS, on the 2nd day of December, 2021, the Unified Government Commission adopted Resolution R-86-21 and published on December 9, 2021, extending the state of local public health emergency through April 1, 2022;

WHEREAS, on the 31st day of March, 2022, the Unified Government Commission adopted Resolution R-20-22 and published on April 7, 2022, extending the state of local public health emergency through July 1, 2022;

WHEREAS, on the 30th day of June, 2022, the Unified Government Commission adopted Resolution R-24-22 and published on July 7, 2022, extending the state of local public health emergency through October 1, 2022;

WHEREAS, on the 29th day of September, 2022, the Unified Government Commission adopted Resolution R-58-22 and published on October 6, 2022, extending the state of local public health emergency through February 1, 2023;

WHEREAS, the threat to the public health from the COVID-19 pandemic continues, as evidenced by the national count of 98,777,220 cases and 1,077,303 deaths as of December 6, 2022; in Kansas, there have been 901,422 cases and 9,679 deaths; and in Wyandotte County there have been 44,800 confirmed cases and 539 deaths;

WHEREAS, in Wyandotte County, while 66.2% of the total population has received at least one

dose of the vaccine, only 8% of the population has received the new, updated bivalent COVID-19 booster vaccine, which protects against the newer omicron variant;

WHEREAS, Wyandotte County is still classified in the “Substantial” category with a weekly cumulative incidence rate of 88 per 100,000 population;

WHEREAS, many Wyandotte County residents have transitioned to utilizing their own at-home tests and not officially reporting the results, making it much more difficult to assess the scope of community spread;

WHEREAS, Wyandotte County residents continue to rely on the UG Public Health Department to provide access to COVID-19 resources, including testing, vaccinations, social support, access to health care, communications, and education, and those resources cannot be provided without the 90% federal match through FEMA;

WHEREAS, the Unified Government Board of Commissioners recognizes that a prolonged public health crisis requires the timely commitment of federal resources that flow to local units of government under an uninterrupted declared emergency;

WHEREAS, the past two winters have brought pronounced increases in COVID-19 cases, hospitalizations, and deaths and the cyclical nature of COVID-19 indicates that a similar increase is likely to be repeated in the winter of 2022-23;

WHEREAS, influenza cases in the United States are currently very high and continuing to rise, putting an additional strain on the health care system and its resources, and, locally, with influenza activity in the state of Kansas being classified as “very high” per CDC data;

WHEREAS, federal and state funding for local health department COVID-19 mitigation strategies has declined substantially and requires greater reliance on FEMA reimbursement for COVID-19 activities;

WHEREAS, the Unified Government Board of Commissioners has the authority to further extend the declaration beyond February 1, 2023, as such conditions continue to endanger the public health, safety, and welfare of persons within the borders of Wyandotte County, Kansas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE UNIFIED GOVERNMENT OF WYANDOTTE COUNTY/ KANSAS CITY, KANSAS, AS FOLLOWS:


1. That the state of local public health emergency in Wyandotte County, Kansas, initially declared on the 13th day of March 2020, shall continue and remain in effect through May 1, 2023, unless terminated earlier.


2. That the response and recovery aspects of all local disaster plans which are applicable to Wyandotte County, Kansas, shall initiate the rendering of aid and assistance thereunder.

3. That any rights or powers lawfully exercised or any actions taken pursuant to local disaster emergency plans shall continue and have full force and effect as authorized by law through May 1, 2023, unless modified or terminated in the manner prescribed by law.
