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Program Helps Ensure Economic Security

This year, the Social Security Administration (SSA) celebrates 50 years of administering the Supplemental Security Income (SSI) program. President Richard Nixon signed the bill in 1972, and in January 1974, SSA began issuing the first SSI payments to nearly 4 million eligible people. The goal of the SSI program was to aid aged, blind, and individuals with disabilities with very limited income and resources.

Fifty years later, the SSI program remains a lifeline by providing cash assistance to about 2% of the U.S. population, approximately 7.5 million people, with limited income and resources, including nearly 1 million low-income children with disabilities. SSI benefits can help pay for basic needs like rent, food, clothing, and medicine, reducing the number of people in extreme poverty, and alleviating the burden on other family members.

"SSI works, and has for the last 50 years, because of hardworking and dedicated SSA employees. SSI is an effective yet complex program, and SSA employees work hard to ensure payments are accurate and timely," said Martin O'Malley, Commissioner of Social Security. "Recently, we made great progress in strengthening the SSI program by simplifying the rules and helping more people access these benefits. As we celebrate 50 years of SSI, we will continue to look for ways to improve the program and eliminate barriers."

The agency recently announced it will expand access to the SSI program by updating the definition of a public assistance household. (Refer to Press Release | Press Office | SSA) The agency also announced it will exclude the value of food from SSI benefit calculations. (Refer to Press Release | Press Office | SSA) Additionally, the agency announced it will expand its rental subsidy exception, currently only in place for SSI applicants and recipients residing in seven States, as a nationwide policy. The agency will commemorate SSI's 50th anniversary with local and national events throughout the year, including a celebration on June 5th hosted by the National Academy of Social Insurance (NASI) featuring Commissioner O'Malley and U.S. Senator Tom Harkin (Ret-IA).

Hobby or business: What people need to know

How taxpayers can decide if it's a hobby or business

These questions can help taxpayers decide whether they have a hobby or business:

• Does the time and effort

they put into the activity show they intend to make a profit?

• Does the activity make a profit in some years, and if so, how much profit does it make?

• Can they expect to make a future profit from the appreciation of the assets used in the activity?

• Do they depend on income from the activity for their livelihood?

• Are any losses due to circumstances beyond their control or are the losses normal for the startup phase of their type of business?

• Do they change their methods of operation to improve profitability?

• Do they carry out the activity in a businesslike manner and keep complete and accurate books and records?

• Do the taxpayer and their advisors have the knowledge needed to carry out the activity as a successful business?

Whether taxpayers have a hobby or run a business, good recordkeeping throughout the year will help when they file taxes.

Inoperable vehicles shall be stored inside an enclosed building. Outside storage shall not include wrecked or salvage vehicles. Any vehicle parked or stored outside must be on an improved surface, located on the same land parcel as the business use, and be parked within a regulation dimension parking stall. AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE PERMISSIBLE TIME AND PLACE FOR MOBILE VENDING VEHICLES AND FOR THEIR **OPERATION WITHIN THE** PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY, AND CREATING A NEW PENALTY FOR UNLAWFUL DUMPING OF GARBAGE

WHEREAS, regulating mobile vending within the public right-ofway is a goal of the Department of Planning and Urban Design;

WHEREAS, the Streets for People Ordinances were passed in 2020, which regulated mobile

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(3)<u>(4)</u> All mobile vending vehicles and prepared food vending vehicles must comply with the following standards:

The vehicle may only park on improved, paved surfaces. The vehicle is not b.

parked in a designated ADA parking space or in an access aisle. The vehicle is not C.

parked in a no-parking zone. d. No mobile vendor vehicle is allowed to take up space or interfere with the operations within a visibly designated loading/unloading zone.

There is sufficient e. stacking area for pedestrians to queue on a sidewalk or on site.

Any portion of rightf. of-way where the speed limit is greater than 40 miles per hour.

Mobile vending vehicles g. may not park in any one site for no more than: four eight hours; except that a mobile vending vehicle shall not be stored in a public right-of-way overnight where the mobile vending vehicle is operating.

<u>h.</u> Mobile vending vehicles shall not park in a fire lane.

Mobile vending vehicles shall not park in an electrical charging station unless it is an electrical vehicle actively charging.

Mobile vending vehicles shall not operate lights or signs with a rotating beam or flashing beacon, and no lighting or signage shall be directed toward any residentially zoned area or traffic in the rightof-way.

Mobile vending activity (4)(5) includes the use of the mobile vendor vehicles or prepared food vending vehicles, areas for queueing, vending, and eating, signage, and trash and recycling receptacles. All mobile market activity must comply with the following:

A mobile vending vehicle that uses a parking space served by a parking meter is exempt from paying for said meter while occupying the parking space, and the time limit on parking meters when used in the manner described in this subsection is waived. This waiver of a time limit does not allow a mobile vending vehicle to operate outside of the hours of operation in this subsection.

No mobile vending or b. vending vehicle shall be located within 15 feet of a fire hydrant or bus stop, or a greater distance if required by state law;

No mobile vending or mobile vehicle shall be located within 20 feet of an intersection or street corner;

d All sidewalks or pedestrian ways must be kept clear and unencumbered so that the sidewalk or pedestrian walkway remains ADA-compliant.

Vehicular and personal e. access to all ADA-compliant parking spaces and access aisles must remain clear and unencumbered.

All fire lanes must ref. main clear and unencumbered.

No sightlines or sight g. distance triangles at street corners and intersections may be obstructed as per code;

No mobile market vendh. ing or vending vehicle is allowed to take up space or interfere with the operations within a visibly designated loading/unloading zone;

WHEREAS, after hearing concerns from the public and from business owners regarding mobile vending, updates to the current ordinances are needed;

WHEREAS, the amendment will prevent mobile vending within 100 feet of a standalone food establishment; and

WHEREAS, changes in hours of operations for public right-of-way mobile vending will help business owners and residents living near the operations of mobile vendors;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE UNIFIED GOVERNMENT OF WYANDOTTE COUNTY/KANSAS CITY. KANSAS:

Section 1. That original Section 32-188 of the Code of the Unified Government of Wvandotte County/Kansas City, Kansas, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 32-188. - Mobile Vending - Public Right-of-Way

This section is for mobile vending within the public right-of-way. For mobile vending on private property, see section 27-620.

(a) Administrative review.

Any persons or entity (1)operating a mobile vendor vehicle or prepared food vending vehicle must conduct such operation under a valid and current business license. The business license can be reviewed for revocation at any time during the year if complaints of non-compliance are submitted.

Mobile vendors must (2)display either a temporary sign (as defined by section 27-729(b)(1)) or signage attached to the vehicle indicating proof of business license, fire department inspection and approval and contact information for appeals/complaints.

Mobile vendor vehicles (3) or prepared food vending vehicles may operate 8:00 a.m. until 11:00 p.m. -7:00 p.m. Sunday through Thursday and 8:00 a.m. <u>until</u> 12:00 midnight -8:00 p.m. Friday and Saturday.

(b) Allowed areas.

Mobile vending is (1)allowed adjacent to any non-residential zoning district upon obtaining a business license or non-profit status as addressed in subsection (a)(1).

(2)If a street is designated by the major street plan a local or neighborhood street, or is otherwise unidentified, and one or more residential residentially zoned properties abut said street, then the mobile vending vehicle is prohibited from parking, operating, or otherwise vending at that location. A mobile vending vehicle or prepared food vending vehicle may only park and operate on said street if the vehicle operator is invited for a block party. The mobile vending vehicle may only stay for the duration of the block party

(3) Mobile vendors selling prepared food shall not park their mobile vending vehicles in the public right-of-way within 100 feet of the lot boundary line of a parcel containing a brick-andmortar food-establishment. This parking restriction shall not apply to a food establishment owner parking a mobile vending vehicle in the public right-of-way within 100 feet of the main entrance of their own food establishment.

i. All areas designated for or reasonably designated for queuing in order to order, purchase, or receive a product from a mobile vendor or vending vehicle must be located at least five feet from passing automobile traffic.

j. Proper trash and recycling receptacles must be made available and utilized. The operator is responsible for removing the trash and recycling associated with the operation of the mobile vendor vehicle or prepared food vending vehicle. Any and all signage, temporary or other structures, and other elements of the mobile vending must be removed at the end of each mobile vending event.

(c) Temporary structures.(1) No permanent structure or improvement shall be installed.

(2) No temporary structure may be secured in any manner that damages the right-of-way. Weights are encouraged to be used to secure temporary structures.

(3) No mobile vendor vehicle or prepared food vending vehicle, structure, or related infrastructure is allowed to take up space or interfere with the operations within a visibly designated loading/ unloading zone <u>or fire lane</u>.

(d) Signage.

(1) Signs otherwise compliant with the sign code in regard to size, material, and presentation can be safely attached to temporary structures.

a. All signs allowed under this subsection may not be used outside of the hours of operation or used in a manner that violates any other ordinance.

b. Signs cannot be attached to public infrastructure.

(2) Sandwich boards are allowed in connection with the mobile vendor vehicle or prepared food vending vehicle.

a. Sandwich boards must be placed within five feet of the mobile vendor vehicle or prepared food vending vehicle and do not interfere with the flow of pedestrian or automobile traffic.

b. Sandwich boards are otherwise subject to all other sign code regulations.

Section 2. That original Section 31-16 of the Code of the Unified Government of Wyandotte County/ Kansas City, Kansas, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 31-16. - Penalties.

(a) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (c) of this section, any Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this chapter, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be sentenced, upon conviction, to a fine of not less than \$500.00 or more than \$2,500.00, to imprisonment for a term of not exceeding six months, or both. Each day that a violation of this chapter shall continue shall constitute a separate offense. The prosecution of any violation as a public offense pursuant to this section subsection (a) may be in addition to, or as an alternative to, any other remedy or course of action available to the unified government.

(b) In addition to the penalties provided for in subsection (a) of this section, the costs incurred pursuant to section 31-4(e) shall be assessed against the responsible party.

(c) Any person who shall violate Sec. 31-12 through the unlawful

dumping of garbage, as defined in Sec. 31-1, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be sentenced, upon conviction, to a fine of not less than \$1,000.00 or more than \$2,500.00, to imprisonment for a term of not exceeding twelve months, or both. Each day that a violation of this chapter shall continue shall constitute a separate offense. The prosecution of any violation as a public offense pursuant to this section may be in addition to, or as an alternative to, any other remedy or course of action available to the unified government.

Section 3. That said original sections 32-188 and 31-16 be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 4. If any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any persons or circumstances is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or application of the Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval, and a summary published in the official Unified Government newspaper.

Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the Projects may include the design, development and construction and of an innovative trail, public gathering space and commercial facilities on the Bridge, consisting of a variety of components and unique offerings, including: (a) a public pathway across the Bridge to connect the West Bottoms area of Kansas City, Missouri to existing levee trails along the west side of the Kansas River and associated amenities; (b) multi-purpose commercial space located on the Bridge consisting of an open-air coffee roastery/shop and bar, one or more restaurants, and retail; (c) unique common spaces for public gathering and viewing, events and entertainment; and (d) an outdoor food hall, including commercial kitchens for local chefs to serve visitors.

SECTION 4. Estimated Cost. The estimated total costs of the Projects are \$14,989,212.55.

SECTION 5. Method of Financing; No CID Bonds. It is proposed that the Projects be financed through a combination of private equity, private debt, certain grant moneys received from the State of Kansas, and available funds of the UG in an amount not to exceed \$2,471,678.80 (plus interest and subject to modification by the UG), and pay-as-you-go CID financing (including the CID Sales Tax), as defined in the Act and that certain Kaw River Bridge Cooperative and Development Agreement dated as of June 7, 2021 (together with any and all amendments thereto, the "Agreement") between the UG and Flying Truss, LLC, a Missouri limited liability company ("Developer"). The UG is not obligated to issue bonds or other obligations in connection with the Projects.

SECTION 6. Proposed CID Sales Tax. It is proposed that the Projects be financed in part through the levying of a 2.0% CID Sales Tax as authorized by the Act, with such CID Sales Tax to commence on October 1, 2024, or such other date as shall be approved by ordinance of the Governing Body, and to continue for a maximum term of 22 years.

SECTION 7. Map and Legal Description of Proposed CID. The legal description of the property to be contained in the proposed CID is set forth on Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein. A map generally outlining the boundaries of the proposed CID is attached as Exhibit B hereto, and incorporated by reference herein. SECTION 8. Notice of Hearing. The UG Clerk is hereby authorized,

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ordered and directed to give notice of the public hearing by publication of this Resolution in the official newspaper at least once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks. The second publication shall be at least seven (7) days prior to the date of the hearing. The UG Clerk is hereby further ordered and directed to mail a copy of this Resolution, via certified mail, to all property owners within the proposed CID at least 10 days prior to the date of the hearing.

SECTION 9. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption by the Governing Body.


